# “Frankenstein Candy Pouch”

## MATERIAL

- 2 black buttons 1 cm diameter
- Sewing needle and scissors

## INSTRUCTIONS

### BODY (2 PIECES):

Chain 23 in Green yarn nr. 00418 or Violet yarn nr. 00422.

Round 1: Make 1 sc in second ch from the hook + 1 sc in each chain along. Turn the work.

Round 2: Ch 1 + 1 sc in first st; 1 sc in each st along. Turn the work.

Round 3 to 24: Repeat Round 2.

Change to Black yarn nr. 01332.

Round 25: Ch 1 + 1 sc in first st; 1 sc in next st inserting the hook 1 rnd down to take yok; 1 sc in following st inserting the hook 2 rnds down to take yok.

\*Make 1 sc in next st; 1 sc in following st inserting the hook 1 rnd down to take yok; 1 sc in following st inserting the hook 2 rnds down to take yok\*. Rep \*\* until the end of the rnd. Turn the work.

Rounds 26 to 28: Repeat Round 2.

Round 29: Ch 2 + 1 dc in first st. Make 1 dc in each st until the end of the rnd. Turn the work.

Round 30: Repeat Round 2. Fasten off.

### FEET (2 PIECES):

Chain 4 in Grey yarn nr. 00269. Close it in a ring by making 1 ss in first chain.

Round 1: Ch 1 + 6 sc in the ring. Join to first sc with 1 ss.

Round 2: Ch 1 + 1 incr in each st along. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 12 sc

Round 3: Ch 1 + 1 sc in each st. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 12 sc

Round 4: Ch 1 + 1 sc in first st. \*Make 1 dec in next 2 sts + 1 sc in following st\*. Rep \*\* until the end of the rnd. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total 8 sc.

Round 5: Ch 1 + 1 sc in each st. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 8 sc

Rounds 6 to 8: Repeat Round 5. Fasten off.

### ARMS (2 PIECES):

Chain 4 in Green yarn nr. 00418 or Violet yarn n° 00422. Close it in a ring by making 1 ss in first chain.

Round 1: Ch 1 + 9 sc in the ring. Join to first sc with 1 ss. Total: 9 sc.

Round 2: Ch 1 + 1 sc in each stitch along. Join to first sc with 1 ss. Total: 9 sc.

Round 3: Ch1 + \*1sc in first st; 1 dec in next 2 sts\*; rep \*\* until the end of the rnd. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 6 sc.

Round 4: Ch1 + 1 sc in each st along. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 6 sc.

Rounds 5 to 8: Repeat Round 4. Fasten off.

### SCREWS (2 PIECES):

Chain 4 in Grey yarn nr. 00421. Close it in a ring by making 1 ss in first chain.

Round 1: Ch 1 + 6 sc in the ring. Join to first sc with 1 ss.

Round 2: Ch 1 + 1 incr in each st along. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 12 sc

Round 3: Ch 1 + 1 sc in each st. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 12 sc

Round 4: Ch 1 + 1 sc in first st. \*Make 1 dec in next 2 sts + 1 sc in following st\*. Rep \*\* until the end of the rnd. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total 8 sc.

Round 5: Ch 1 + 1 sc in each st. Join to first st with 1 ss. Total: 8 sc

Round 6: Repeat Round 5. Fasten off.

### WHITE EYE:

Chain 4 in White yarn nr. 01331. Close it in a ring making 1 ss in first chain.

Ch 3 (counted as first dc) + make 11 pa in the ring. Join to first dc with 1 ss. Fasten off.

### FINISH

1.- Sew Arms, Feet and Screws to Body Back piece.

2.- Sew White Eye and the 2 buttons to Body Front piece.

3.- Embroider mouth and scar on Body Front piece in Black yarn nr. 01332.

4.- Face both Body Pieces and join them by sewing them in Green yarn nr. 00418 or Violet yarn nr. 00422.

5.- Chain 70 in Black yarn nr. 01332 and insert it through the dc stitches in Round 29. Join both ends with 1 ss. Fasten off.

### ABBREVIATIONS USED IN THIS PATTERN (USA CROCHET TERMS):

ch /s: chain / s

ss: slip stitch

sc: single crochet

incr: 2 single crochet made in same space.

dec: 2 single crochet closed together

dc: double crochet

st / s: stitch / es

rnd: round

sp: space

yok: yarn over the hook

prev: previous

rep \*\*: repeat from \* to \*

### WASHING INSTRUCTIONS

All our threads are produced in accordance with Oeko-tex standards. PH values are tested and all our colors dye lots adhere to Global fastness standards. However, it is important to follow our thread washing instructions. Particularly with dark colors, excess dye can remain on the thread. To minimize any potential bleeding of excess dyestuff it is important to wash the products in THE HOTTEST TEMPERATURE possible, in accordance with the specifications of the fabrics, and use a large amount of water. Please make sure that you also follow the fabric washing instructions. As a precaution, you can also use decolorating sheets that you can find in any supermarket.
