dec - decrease

dc – double crochet

hdc - half double crochet

### Materials:

Yarn (you can use any kind of yarn just make sure you have a suitable hook)

2.5 mm hook size or a size that fits your yarn

2 black 6mm safety eyes

Scissors

Stuffing

Tapestry needle

Stitch marker

For the edging, you'll be needing a fur-like yarn. I've used Schachenmayr soft yarn.

# You can use any kind of yarn you like with the right size of hook The specific yarns that I:

### Some information before you start.

- Work in spiral rounds unless otherwise stated
- Stuff your doll as you go
- Change the colour always in the last step of the last stitch
- mark the beginning of your rounds with a stitch marker
- You crochet the doll from the head down to the toes in one piece.

  Arms, Hair and Dress are separate pieces.
- with the described yarn the doll is about 23 cm tall

## **Head:**

(Colour creme)

- 1:6 sc in magic ring (6)
- 2: (inc)x6 (12)
- 3: (sc, inc)x 6 (18)
- **4**: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
- **5**: (3 sc, inc) x6 (30)
- **6**: (4 sc, inc) x6 (36)
- **7**: (5 sc, inc) x6 (42)
- **8**: (6 sc, inc) x6 (48)
- **9**: (7 sc, inc) x6 (54)
- **10-18 :** 54 sc (54) (9 rnds)

If you use safety eyes place them between round 15 und 16, the space between the eyes is about 10 stitches.



If you want to embroider lashes is easier to do this before you place the safety eyes.

Alternative you can also embroider some cute closed eyes

- **19**: (7 sc, dec)x 6 (48)
- **20 :** 3 sc, dec, (6 sc, dec) x5, 3 sc (42)
- **21**: (5 sc, dec) x6 (36)
- $-\cdot > Stuff$  the head firmly

- **22**: 2 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)x5, 2 sc (30)
- **23**: (3 sc, sc) x6 (24)
- **24:** 1 sc, dec, (2 sc, dec) x5, 1 sc (18)
- **25**: (1 sc, dec) x6 (12)
- **26-28 :** 12 sc (12) (3 rnds)

 $-\cdot \Rightarrow$  Don't break yarn continue with the body.

To give the head a better stability use a chopstick and stuff firmly around it.

## **Body:**

(colour creme)

- **29**: (1sc, inc) x 6 (18)
- 30: change colour to rose
- $(2 \text{ sc, inc}) \times 6$  (24)
- **31**: (3 sc , inc) x6 (30)
- **32 39 :** 30 sc (30) (8 rnds)
- **40:** change colour to dark blue:
  - $30 \text{ sc in } \mathbf{BLO}$  (30)
- **41-44:** 30 sc (30) (4 rnds)
- $-\cdot$  > Stuff the body
- $\longrightarrow$  Don't break yarn continue with Leg 1



## **Legs:**

(Colour dark blue)

You will have to contine working with the first leg right after the last round of the body.

Use 4 stitch markers to mark the beginning and end of each leg. See photo for reference.

Each leg will have 12sts and the 3 sts in between will be the spaces

You will have to sew the space between the legs to close using the starting tail.

From the last sc of the body, make 12 sc coming from the blue towards the pink one. Go back to start the next round. Continue with pattern.



## **Leg 1:**

(Colour dark blue)

1: continue in Round 41; 12 fm

2: Start this round by going back to the first sc of Round 1, make 12 sc (12)

3 - 20 : 12 sc (12)

(18 Rnd)

21 :Change colour to light blue in **BLO** 12 fm (12)

**22-26**: 12 sc (12)

(5 rnds)

- Don't forget to stuff your leg!
- Don't break yarn, continue with the shoes

## **Leg 2:**

(Colour dark blue)


Leave a long starting tail for sewing the gaps later. Skip 3 sts from leg 1, and start at the fourth stitch.

1:12 sc

2: first sc of this round in first sc of the 12 sc you made before

3 -26: like the first leg

- Don't break yarn continue with the shoe
- Close the gap between the legs (the three stitches on each side)



## **Shoes (2x):**

(Colour dark blue)

Sc until you reach the middle on the back of the doll

So that the following increases are on the front of side of the doll.



Sc until you reach the mittle

Don't mind the colour on this picture

30: Change colour to rose

31: Change colour to white, in BLO:

$$4 \text{ sc}, (\text{dec}) \times 8, 4 \text{ sc}$$
 (16)

-- > Pull yarn through last stitch, close round invisible

 $-\cdot >$  *Make the second shoe the same way* 

### Socks (2x):

(Colour crème fur (soft) yarn)

Crochet in the remaining sc of round 30 (2 ch, slst. in next stitch) x12

Break yarn and sew in the ends.

Make the second one the same way.



## **Arms:** (2x)

(colour creme)

 $-\cdot$  > Don't stuff the arms.

23: ch, faltten the arms and close them with 4 sc

 $-\cdot$  Make the second arm the same way

- · ➤ Sew them on the body.

Between round. 28 and 29.

### Skirt:

Colour rose

Turn the doll upside down and contine in the remaining Front Loops in the body.

- 1: 3 ch (does count as first dc), (2 dc in next stitch, dc) x 14, 2 dc in next st, slst in top of the beginning chs. (45)
- 2-5: 3 ch, 44 dc, slst in top of the beginning chs (45) (4 rnds)

(14)

Embroider some triangles on the skirt.

## Jacket:

### Top:

(colour light blue)

- 1: 33 ch, turn (32)
- 2:1 sc in second loop from the hook 31 sc, ch turn (32)
- **3-7:** 32 sc, ch turn (32)(5 rnds)
- 8: 4 sc, 7 ch, skip 7 stitches, 10 sd, 7 ch, skip 7 stitches,
- (32)9:32 sc (32)

yarn and sew in the ends

## **Arms of Jacket: (2x)**

(colour light blue)

4 sc, ch turn



Start in the front loop of the last stitch before the 7 ch

- 1: FLO sc, 7 sc in 7 ch, FLO 6 sc
- **2-15**: 14 sc (14)(14 rnds)
- Break yarn and sew in the ends
- $-\cdot >$  Make the second one the same way

### **Bottom:**

(colour light blue)



- turn work and crochet in the remaining loops of the 32 ch
- 1: 2 ch and dc in same st, (2 dc in next sc, dc) x 15, dc, 2 ch turn (47)
- **2-5:** 47 dc, 2 ch turn (47)(4 rnds)

Break yarn and sew in the ends.

## **Hood:**

Colour light blue

1: 56 ch

2: dc in third stitch from the hook, 52 dc (54)

3-6: 2 ch turn, 54 dc (54) (4 rnds)

7-9: 1 ch turn, 4 sc, 20 dc, 6 sc, 20 dc, 4 sc (54) (3 rnds)

faltten the Hood in the middle:

Ch, sc in both sides of the last row, 26 sc (27)

Turn inside out to hide the seam





## **Fur on the Hood:**

Continue with the yarn for the fur in the remaining loops of the ch:

2 ch, 54 dc along the Hood.

Break yarn and sew in the ends.



## Fur on the Jacket:

Continue with the yarn you for the fur on the left side on the top of the jacket.

Work in the ch you make to turn.

2 ch, 7 dc in the ends of the rows with the sc, 10 dc in the ends of the rows with the dc,

On the left edge make 2 dc

48 dc along the last row of bottom of the jacket

2 dc int the right edge

10 dc in the ends of the rows with the dc, 7 dc in the ends of the rows with the sc

Break yarn and sew in the ends.



## Fur on the arms of the jaket(x2):

Continue with the fur yarn on the last round of the arms of the dress

1:14 sc around the arms of the jacket, slst in first sc,

Break yarn and sew in the ends.

Make the second one the same way.



## **Sewing the Hood on the jacket:**

Place the hood and jacket good side to good side.

Make sure both are aligned with each other.

Sew them together using whip stitch.



#### Note:

If you want you can sew some buttons on the jacket to close the jacket later

Sew them on the cotton yarn not on the fur yarn on the jacket.



## <u>Hair:</u>

(Colour black)

l :	6	sc in	magic	ring		(6)
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$$2: (inc) \times 6$$
 (12)



<b>8</b> : (6 sc, inc) x 6	(48)
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 $\rightarrow$ 

The number of rounds depends on how much you stuffed your head. If it seems to be too small just add one or two rounds or if it appears too large just make less than 10 rounds.

**— ·>** Break yarn and close round invisible

### **Braids:**

Cut some 35 cm long of black yarn for the hair. Fold each one of them in halves.

Insert your hook into a stitch in one side at the back of the hair.

Grab three yarns (or depending on how thick you want the braid of your doll) and place the folded part of black yarns on hook, and pull it through the stitch just enough to form a loop. Grab the remaining tail of the black yarns and pull it all through the loop. Repeat the process until you're happy with the thickness of the braid.

Braid the hair and secure the bottom by making a knot using another piece of black yarn. Do the same thing for the other side.

Pull the strands here on the back oft the hair.



## **Shoelaces:**

(follow the steps showed on the pictures below)







#### EXTRA NOTES:

For nice cheeks use a brush and put some blush on, or embroider some cheeks with a pink yarn.

You can also embroider a nose with crème colored yarn if you want to.

## Now you finally made it! Time to build a igloo!



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
