



MATERIALS

Caron® Simply Soft® (Solids: 6 oz /170.1g; 315 yds/288 m; Paints: 4 oz/ 113.4 g; 204 yds/186 m; Heathers: 5 oz/141.7 g; 250 yds/228 m)

Contrast A Sticks and Stones (P0009) **1 ball**

Contrast B Charcoal Heather (H9508) **1 ball**

Contrast C Grey Heather (H9509) **1 ball**

Contrast D Off White (39702) **2 balls**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Stitch marker.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" x 100" [25.5 x 254 cm],
excluding fringe.

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Granny Square (make 10)

See diagram on page 2.

With A, ch 4. Join with sl st to first ch to form a ring.

1st rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 11 dc in ring. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 12 dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. 2 dc in each of next 11 dc. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. 24 dc.

3rd rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 1. Skip next dc. 3 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last dc. Ch 1. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

4th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Ch 2. 3 dc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * around to last 3 dc. Ch 2. Join B with sl st to top of ch 3.

5th rnd: Ch 4 (counts as tr). 2 tr in same sp as last sl st. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch 2 sp. Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Ch 1. *(3 tr. Ch 3. 3 tr) in next ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc in next ch-2 sp) twice. Ch 1. Rep from * to last ch-2 sp. 3 tr in last ch-2 sp. Ch 3. Join with sl st to top of beg ch 4.

6th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-3 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in last ch 3 sp. Ch 2. Join C with sl st to top of ch 3.

7th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in corner



ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in last ch 2 sp. Ch 2. Join with sl st to top of ch 3.

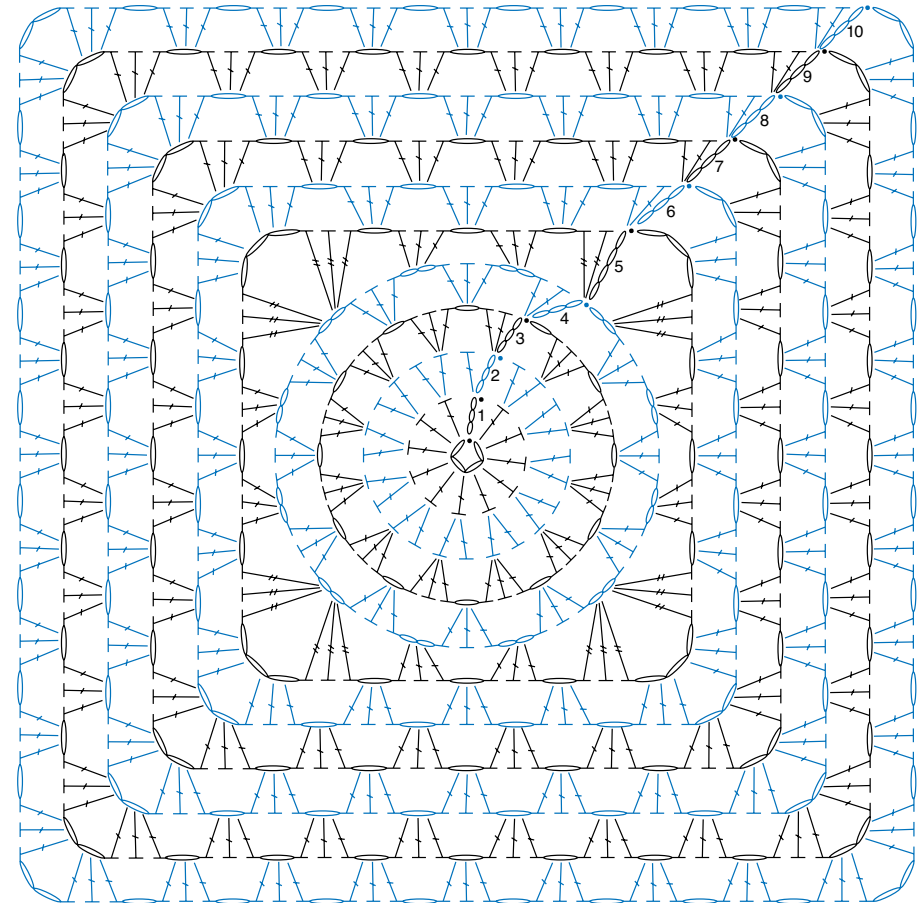
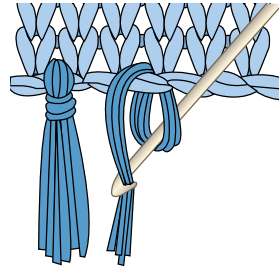
8th rnd: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in last ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Join D with sl st to top of ch 3.

9th and 10th rnds: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 2 dc in same sp as last sl st. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. *Ch 1. (3 dc. Ch 2. 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp. (Ch 1. 3 dc) in each ch-1 sp to next corner ch-2 sp. Rep from * twice more. Ch 1. 3 dc in last ch-2 sp. Ch 2. Join with sl st to top of ch 3. Fasten off.

FINISHING





Sew 10 Granny Squares tog end to end to form Scarf.

Fringe: Cut strands of D 20" [51 cm] long. Taking 4 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe across ends of Scarf. Trim fringe evenly.
