Stitches used

GARTER STITCH (G. st): using 6.5 mm needles. k every row.

STOCKING STITCH (St st), using 6.5 mm needles.

Row 1: k **Row 2:** p

Tension/Gauge

To achieve a good result, it is essential to make a tension square (see Check Your Tension instructions at beginning of one of our pattern books).

14 sts and 18 rows over St st = 10 cm (4 in) square 13 sts and 23 rows over G. st = 10 cm (4 in) square

To make

Arrows on diagram show direction of work.

The front and back are worked in 1 piece starting with right front.

RIGHT FRONT:

Cast on 21-22-24-25-26 sts. Work in G. st for 4-4-6-6-4 rows.

On next row make a 1 st buttonhole as follows:

k2, k2tog, yon, (= 1 buttonhole), work to end.

Continue and work even in G. st for **5-5-3-3- 5** rows.

Work **7** sts in G. st for the border and **14-15-17-18-19** sts in St st.

Continue and work as set until work measures 8-9.5-11-12-12 cm (3-3¾-4¼-4¾-4¾ in) 18-20-22-24-24 rows] total.

Work another 1 st buttonhole as explained.

Continue even until work measures 12.5-14.5-16.5-17.5-18.5 cm (5-53/4-61/4-7-71/4 in) [26-30-32-34-36 rows] total.

Beginning of armholes:

Increase **3** sts on left edge. On obtained **24-25-27-28-29** sts continue working 4 sts in G. st at armhole edge for the border.

When work measures 16-18.5-20-22-23 cm (61/4-71/4-8-83/4-9 in) [32-36-38-42-44 rows] total, make a 1 st buttonhole.


When work measures 24-27.5-29-32-34 cm (9½-10¾-11½ -12½-13¼ in) [46-52-54-60-64 rows] total, make 1 st buttonhole.


Continue even until work measures 26-29-32-34-36 cm (101/4-111/2-121/2-131/2-14 in) [50-56-60-64-68 rows] total.

Front neck edge and back:

For front neck edge cast off **9-10-11-12-12** sts and work to end of row.

Work 1 row even on remaining **15-15-16-16-17** sts. For back neck edge, after the **15-15-16-16-17** sts,





cast on 12-14-15-17-17 extra sts.

Leave obtained 27-29-31-33-34 sts on hold on a stitch holder.

LEFT FRONT:

Cast on **21-22-24-25-26** sts and work in G. st. for **4** cm (**1**½ in)[**10** rows].

Continue and work 14-15-17-18-19 sts in St st, 7 sts in G. st. for the border.

Continue as set until work measures 12.5-14.5-16.5-17.5-18.5 cm (5-5½ -6¼ -6¾ -7¼ in) [26-30-32-34-36 rows] total.

Beginning of armhole:

Increase **3** sts at right edge and continue working 4 sts in G. st at armhole edge for the border.

Continue as set until work measures **26.5-29.5-32.5-34.5-36.5** cm (**10**½ **-11-12½ -13½ -14**¼ in) [51-57-61-65-69 rows] total.

Front neck edge:

Cast off 9-10-11-12-12 sts and work to end of row. Leave remaining 15-15-16-16-17 sts on hold on a stitch holder.

Back:

Place back on needle the 27-29-31-33-34 sts from stitch holder of right front and the 15-15-16-16-17 sts of left front (= 42-44-47-49-51 sts).

Continue and work 4 sts in G. st, 34-36-39-41-43 sts in St st and 4 sts in G. st until work measures 14.5-15.5-16.5-17.5-18.5 cm (5%-6-6%-7-7% in) 26-28-30-32-34 rows from beginning of back.

End of armholes:

Cast off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Continue and work even in St st on remaining 36-38-41-43-45 sts until work measures 23-26-29-31-33 cm (9-101/4-111/2-12-13 in) [41-47-51-55-59 rows] after beginning of back.

Starting on WS of back, work in G. st for 4 cm (1½ in) [10 rows] and cast off all sts knitwise on WS.

RIGHT SLEEVE:

Note: picking up sts along the armhole border naturally tightens the top of sleeve.

Insert a needle from left to right in each G. st ridge of armhole border (= red line on diagram).

26-28-30-32-34 loops obtained on needle = **26-28-30-32-34** sts.

Work in St st and increase 1 st at each end of 1st row (=28-30-32-34-36 sts).

When work measures 10-12-15-17-19 cm $(4-4\frac{3}{4}-6-6\frac{3}{4}-7\frac{1}{2})$ in) [17-21-27-29-33 rows] after beginning of sleeve, on WS, work in G. st for 4 cm $(1\frac{1}{2})$ in) [10 rows] and decrease 4 sts on 3rd row.

Cast off remaining **24-26-28-30-32** sts knitwise on WS.

LEFT SLEEVE:

Work as for right sleeve.

HOOD:

Cast on **57-61-65-67-69** sts and work in G. st for **16.5-17-17.5-18-18** cm (61/4-61/2-63/4-7-7 in) [38-40-41-42-42 rows] total.

Cast off all sts.

FINISHING:


Fold hood in half and sew back of hood.

Sew hood to neck edge border leaving 4 sts free at each end.

Sew sleeves and sides of jacket.

Sew buttons.

Secure and weave in ends.



 When you knit every row, the resulting pattern is called garter stitch.



Row 1 (right side): knit.
Row 2 (wrong side): purl.
Repeat these 2 rows.
