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YARN

To fit age	S	M	L	years

YARN

Felted Tweed

A Carbon 159

3 4 4 x 50gm

B Duck Egg 173

3 4 4 x 50gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles

1 pair 3¾mm (no 9) (US 5) needles

3 ¼mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle

TENSION

23 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 3¾mm (US 5) needles.

BACK

Using 3¾mm (US 5) needles and yarn A cast on 107 [111: 115] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 3 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Beg with a P row, work in st st for 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Join in yarn B.

Now work in striped st st as follows:

Rows 1 to 14: Using yarn B and dec 1 st at each end of 7th of these rows. 105 [109: 113] sts.

Rows 15 to 28: Using yarn A and dec 1 st at each end of 5th of these rows. 103 [107: 111] sts.

These 28 rows form striped st st and beg side seam shaping.

Cont in striped st st, dec 1 st at each end of 3rd and 2 foll 12th rows. 97 [101: 105] sts.

Work 15 rows, ending after 14 rows using yarn B and with RS facing for next row.

Now work in rib as given for lower edge in stripes as follows:

Using yarn A, work 2 rows.

Using yarn B, work 2 rows.

Last 4 rows form striped rib.

Cont in striped rib until back meas 29 [30: 31] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Keeping striped rib correct, cast off 3 [4: 5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 91 [93: 95] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 4 [4: 3] alt rows. 73 [75: 79] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 19 [20: 21] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape back neck and shoulders

Cast off 6 [6: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 61 [63: 65] sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 6 [6: 7] sts, rib until there are 10 [11: 10] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 6 [7: 6] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 29 [29: 31] sts, rib to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back until armhole meas 8 cm, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Shape neck

Next row (WS): Rib 18 [19: 20] and slip these sts onto a holder, cast off centre 37 [37: 39] sts in rib, rib to end. 18 [19: 20] sts.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cont straight until front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 [6: 7] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 [7: 6] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts, rib to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 49 [51: 53] sts.

Work in rib as given for back for 5 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Change to 3¾mm (US 5) needles.

Beg with a P row and a further 9 rows using yarn A, work in striped st as given for back, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 6th and every foll 6th row to 57 [63: 71] sts, then on every foll 8th row until there are 79 [83: 87] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 42 [43: 44] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Keeping stripes correct, cast off 3 [4: 5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 73 [75: 77] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row until 49 sts rem, then on foll 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 31 sts.

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 19 sts.

MAKING UP

Press.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neck edging

With RS facing, using 3¼mm (US 3) circular needle and yarn A, beg and ending at either end of front neck cast-off sts, pick up and knit 28 [30: 32] sts up right side of neck, 37 [37: 39] sts from back, then 28 [30: 32] sts down left side of neck. 93 [97: 103] sts.

Beg with row 1, work in rib as given for back for 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Neatly sew row-end edges of neck edging in place to front neck cast-off sts.

Set in sleeves using the set-in method.
