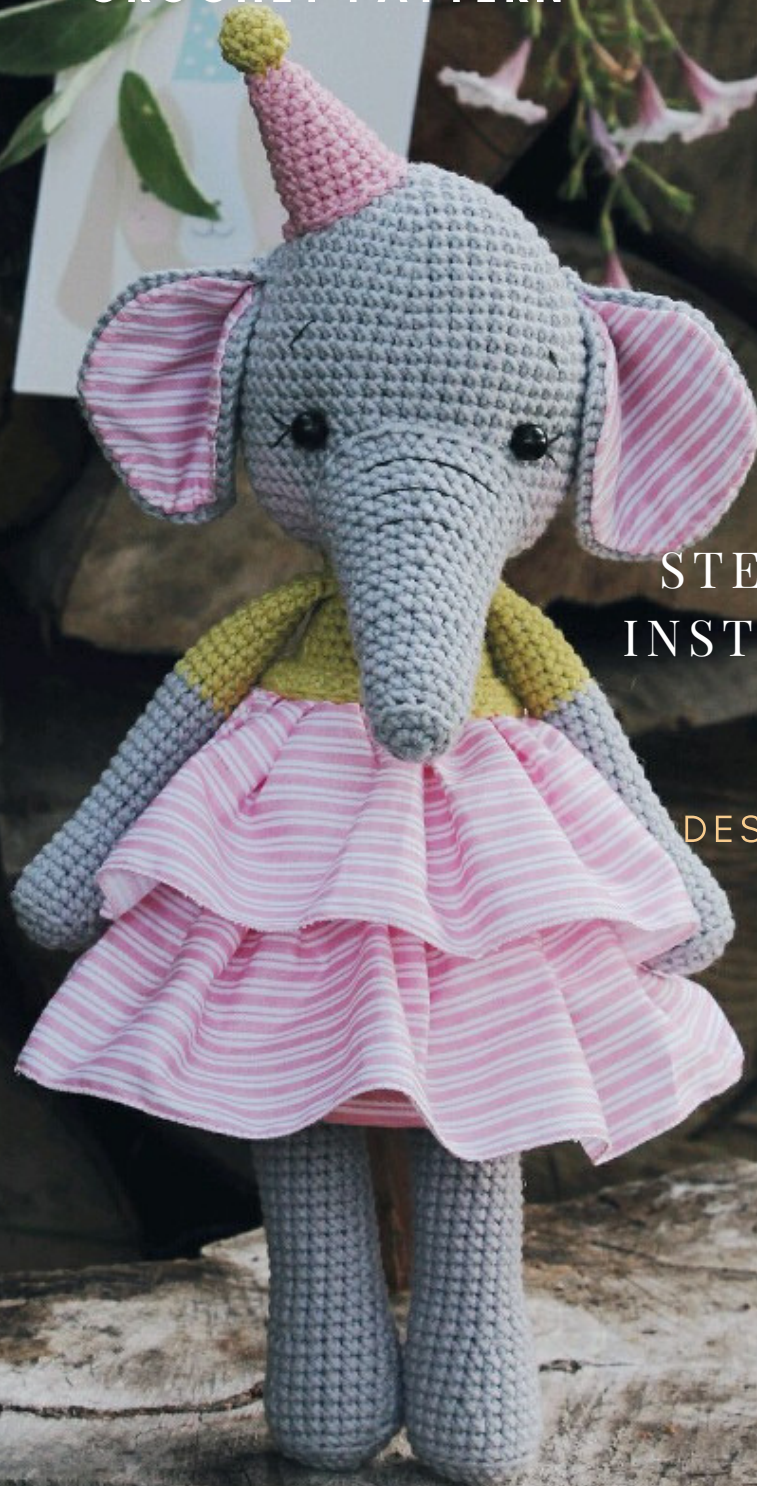

# ELEPHANT WENDY

## Materials and supplies:

1. Fine yarn for body of main color - Grey (I used Alize Cotton Gold №21 light grey 330 m (≈360 yd) /100 g (50% cotton/50% acrylic)) 1 skein
2. Fine yarn of 2 additional colors: pink and light green/lilac for crochet dress (Yarn Art Jeans № 36 pink & №29 apple/№19 lilac (160 m (≈175 yd)/ 50g ), 50% cotton/50% acrylic). Small quantity.  
**NOTE\*** for second option of dress (crochet one), you'll need 1 ball of pink yarn.
3. Hook size 2 mm (metal hooks US 1, UK 1)
4. Piece of fabric for skirt and ears about 50x50cm/19,7X19,7 in
5. Fiber filling
6. Two black plastic beads for eyes.
7. Pinking scissors to cut out fabric for ears (optional).
8. Black thread, sewing needle

## Abbreviations:

- Ch - chain  
Sc - single crochet  
Hdc - half double crochet  
Dc - double crochet  
St - stitch  
Inc - increase (2 sc or 2 dc in one stitch)  
Dec - decrease (crochet next 2 st together)  
[n] Inc/Dec - increase/decrease [n] times in a row  
Sl st - slip stitch  
R - row/round  
( ) x... - repeat instructions in brackets ... times  
Number in ( ) at the end of the Row indicates number of st in that Row

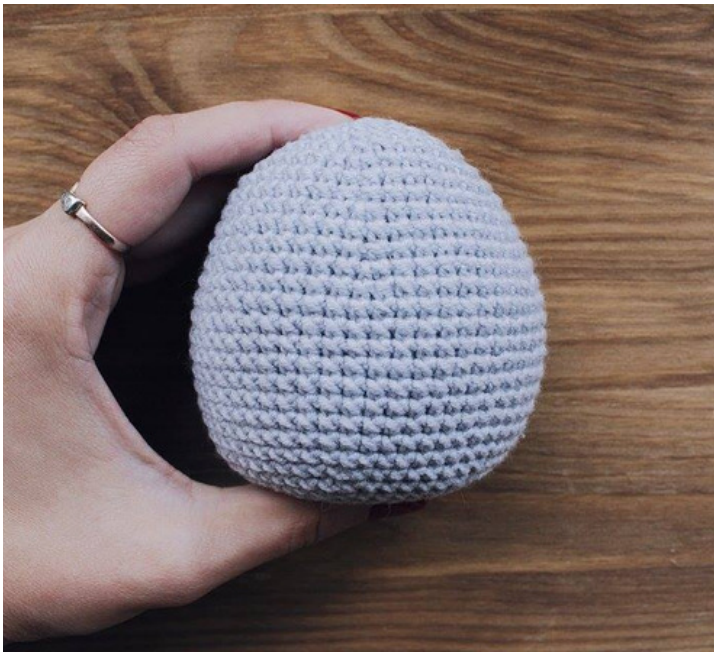
**IMPORTANT!** Different toy details for different outfits are marked as follows:

*Option 1* (for sewed dress) and  
*Option 2* (for crochet dress)  
All other details are the same.

## HEAD:

Work with main color yarn - **Grey**.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

**R7:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R8-9:** 42 sc (2 rounds)

**R10:** (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

**R11-12:** 48 sc (2 rounds)

**R13:** (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)

**R14-23:** 54 sc (10 rounds)

**R24:** (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)

**R25:** (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)

**R26:** (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

Stuff tight.

**R27:** (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

**R28:** (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

**R29:** (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

**R30:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

Stuff to the end tightly.



## EARS (Option 1):

Work with main yarn color - **Grey**.

Make 2 details.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

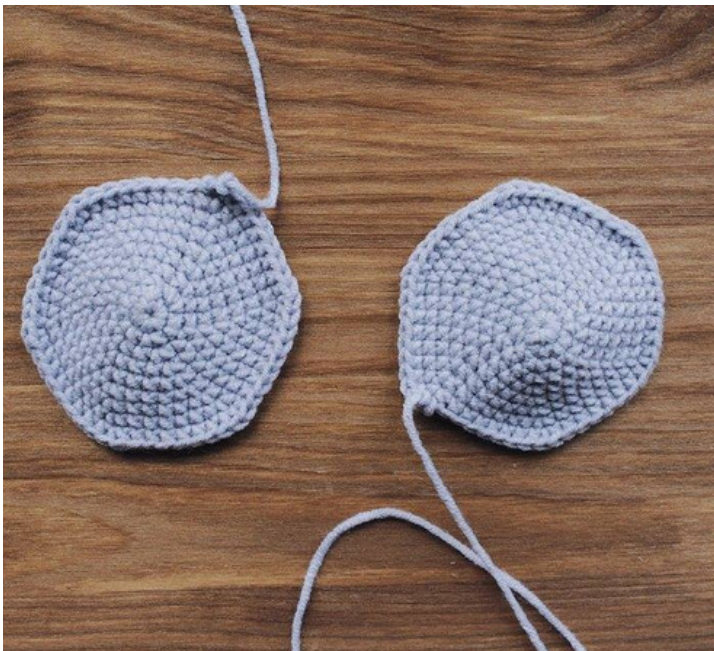
**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

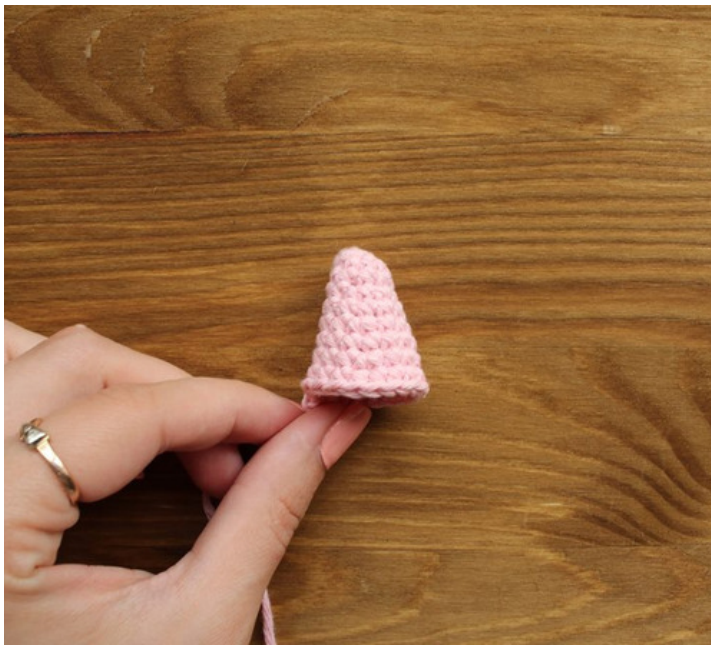
**R7:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R8:** (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

**R9:** (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.





## CONE CAP:

Work with **Pink** yarn color.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** (1 sc, inc) x 3 (9)

**R3:** 9 sc

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 3 (12)

**R5:** 12 sc

**R6:** (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15)

**R7:** 15 sc

**R8:** (4 sc, inc) x 3 (18)

**R9:** 18 sc



For pompon:

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3-4:** 12 sc (2 rounds)

Fasten off the loops to close the hole.  
Leave a tail for assembly.



Sew pompon to the cap.

Stuff the cap before sewing it to the head.



## BODY (Option 1):

Start working with main color yarn - **Grey**.  
Stuff tight enough.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

**R7:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R8:** (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

**R9-18:** 48 sc (10 rounds)

**R19:** 15 sc, (1 sc, dec) x 6, 15 sc (42)

**R20-21:** 42 sc (2 rounds)

**R22:** (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

Change yarn color to **Light green**.

**R23:** 36 sc

**R24:** 36 sc on the back loop of the st

**R25:** (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

**R26-27:** 30 sc (2 rounds)

**R28:** (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

**R29-31:** 24 sc (3 rounds)

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.

In **R24** crocheted on the back loop of the st, crochet top of the dress around with the **Light green** yarn.

**R1-3:** Ch 1, 36 sc, sl st (36).



## TRUNK:

Work with **Grey** color yarn. Stuff tight as you go.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** 12 sc on the back loop of the st

**R4:** (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15)

**R5-7:** 15 sc (3 rounds)

**R8:** (4 sc, inc) x 3 (18)

**R9-11:** 18 sc (3 rounds)

**R12:** (5 sc, inc) x 3 (21)

**R13:** 21 sc

**R14:** (6 sc, inc) x 3 (24)

**R15:** 24 sc

**R16:** (7 sc, inc) x 3 (27)

**R17:** 27 sc

**R18:** (8 sc, inc) x 3 (30)

**R19:** (9 sc, inc) x 3 (33)

**R20:** (10 sc, inc) x 3 (36)

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



## HIND LEGS:

Work with main color yarn - **Grey**.

Stuff tight to the top. Make 2 details.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** 24 sc on the back loop of the st

**R6-7:** 24 sc (2 rounds)

**R8:** (6 sc, dec) x 3 (21)

**R9-11:** 21 sc (3 rounds)

**R12:** (5 sc, dec) x 3 (18)

**R13-37:** 18 sc (25 rounds)

**R38:** (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

**R39:** 12 sc

Fasten off, close the hole. Hide yarn tail inside the leg.





## FRONT LEGS:

Start to crochet with **Grey** color yarn.  
Stuff tight to Row 25. Don't stuff detail after that row. Make 2 details.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** 18 sc on the back loop of the st

**R5:** 18 sc

**R6:** (4 sc, dec) x 3 (15)

**R7-9:** 15 sc (3 rounds)

**R10:** (3 sc, dec) x 3 (12)

**R11-20:** 12 sc (10 rounds)

Change yarn color to **Light green (Lilac** for  
crochet dress).

**R21-30:** 12 sc (10 rounds)

Fold edges together and single crochet them. Cut  
the yarn. Leave long tail for assembly.

## OPTION 2



### EARS (Option 2):

Work with main color yarn - **Grey**.  
Make 2 details.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

**R7:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R8:** (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

**R9:** (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



Work with **Pink** color yarn. Make 2 details.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

Sew pink detail in the middle of grey color detail as shown in the picture.



## BODY (Option 2):

Start working with **Grey** color yarn. Stuff tight.

**R1:** 6 sc in magic ring

**R2:** 6 inc (12)

**R3:** (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

**R4:** (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

**R5:** (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

**R6:** (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

**R7:** (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

**R8:** (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

**R9-15:** 48 sc (7 rounds)

**R16:** 48 sc on the back loop of the st

**R17-18:** 48 sc (2 rounds)

**R19:** 15 sc, (1 sc, dec) x 6, 15 sc (42)

**R20:** 42 sc

**R21:** 42 sc on the back loop of the st

**R22:** (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

Change yarn color to **Lilac**.

**R23:** 36 sc

**R24:** 36 sc on the back loop of the st

**R25:** (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

**R26-27:** 30 sc (2 rounds)

**R28:** (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

**R29-31:** 24 sc (3 rounds)

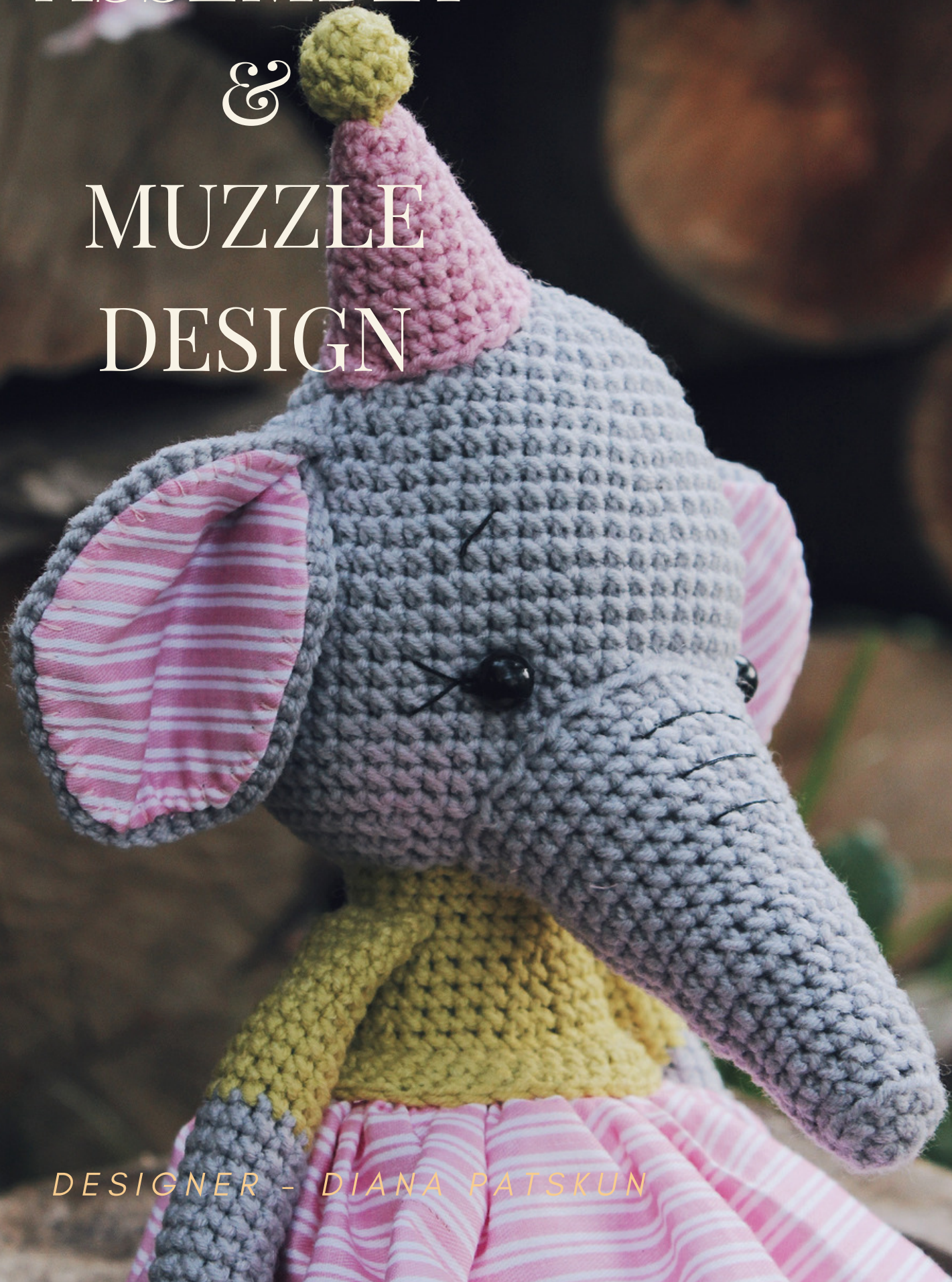
Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.

ASSEMBLY

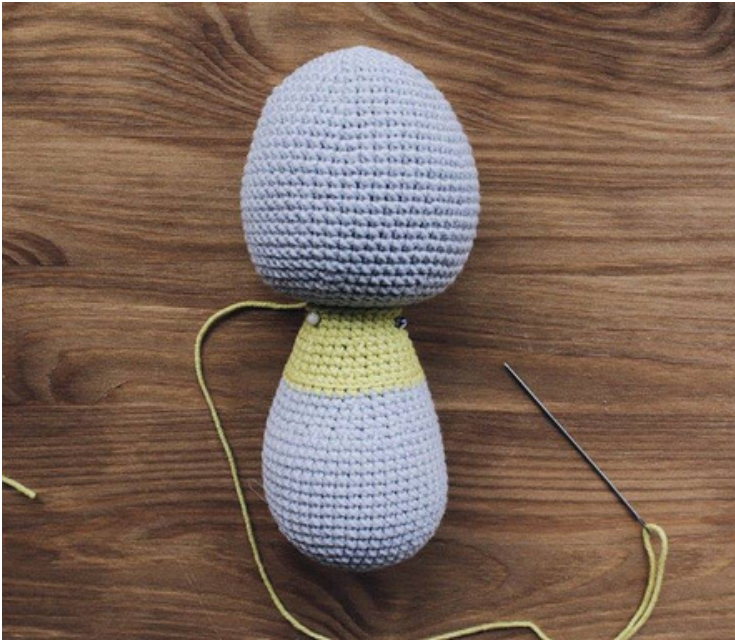

DESIGN



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Sew head to the body.

Place it right in the center. Secure last row (31st) of the body to the 28th row of the head with pins.

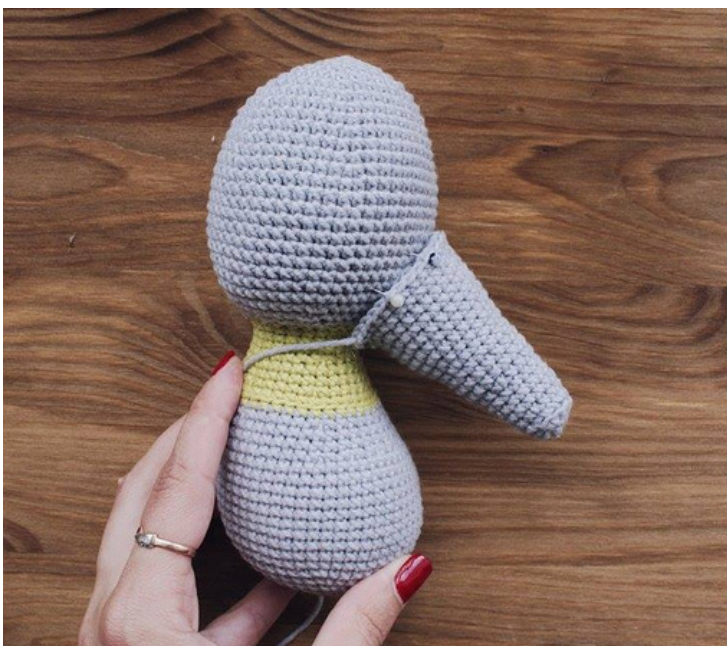
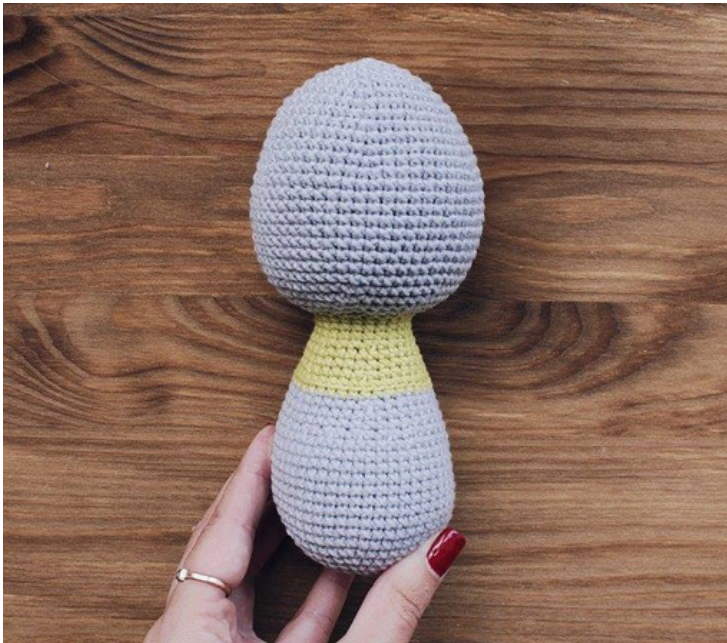
These rows have 24 stitches each that's why it will be easier to sew details together at that level.



Sew details by taking loops of the body first, then head, alternately.



When we have small hole left, stuff the area between head and body tight enough, so our head don't hang out. Then sew details to the end.

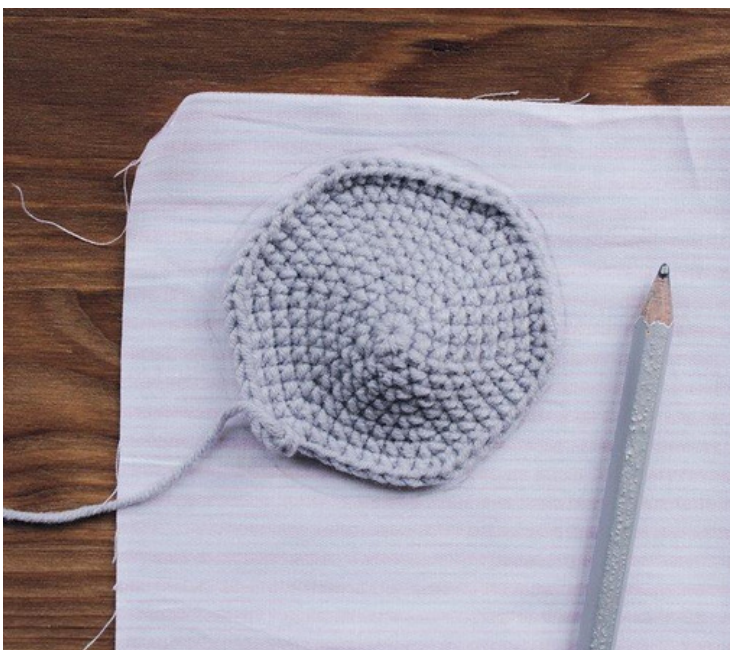


Then sew elephant's trunk previously securing it with the pins.

Top of the trunk place between rows 18-19 of the head. Bottom of the trunk must come in contact with the body. Trunk must look down.

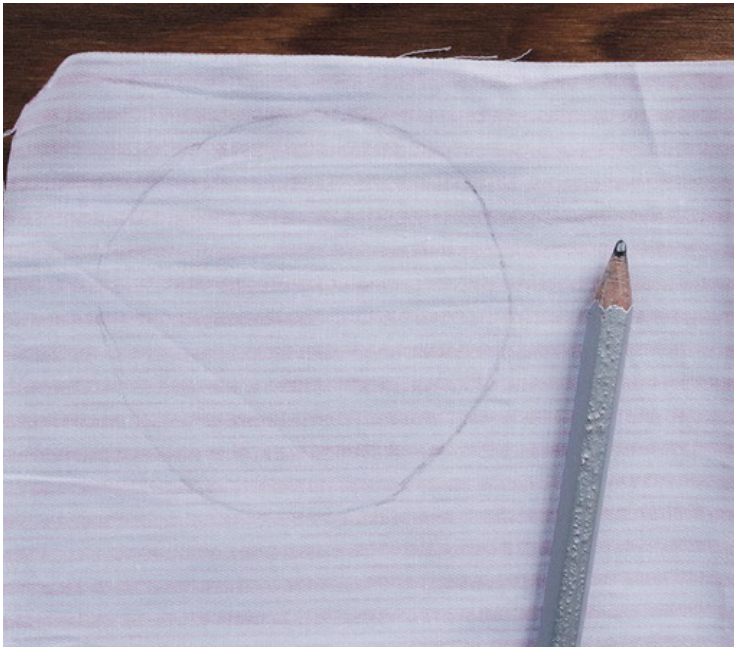


Sew details neatly by taking loops of the trunk first, then head, alternately.



Decorate ear for Option 1.

Fold the fabric in half. Attach ear to the wrong side of the fabric and carefully draw it around the contour.



You can also pin it in the middle so that fabric does not slip.



Cut out the contour with the pinking scissors. We'll get two identical details in this way.



Sew fabric to the ears with the sewing thread, bending it before.



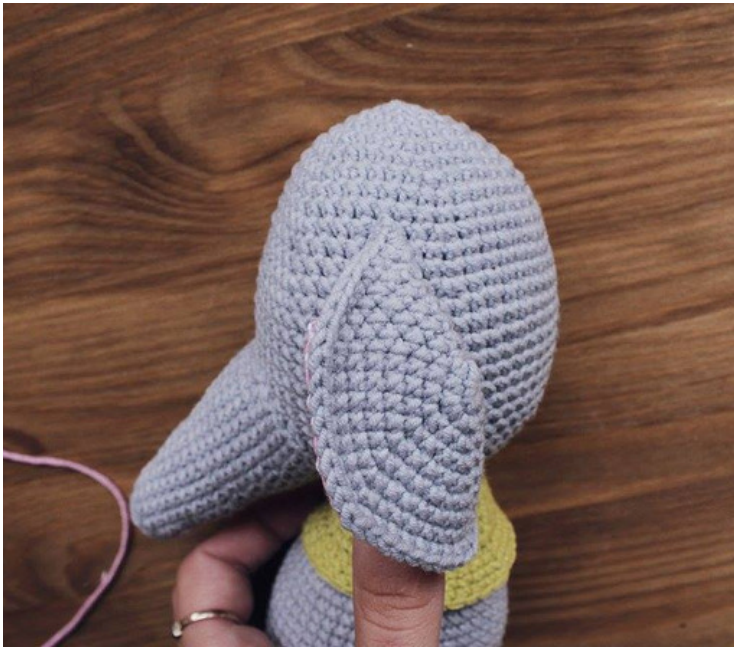


Iron well. Ears are ready.



Secure ears on the head with the pins.





Neatly sew ears to the head.

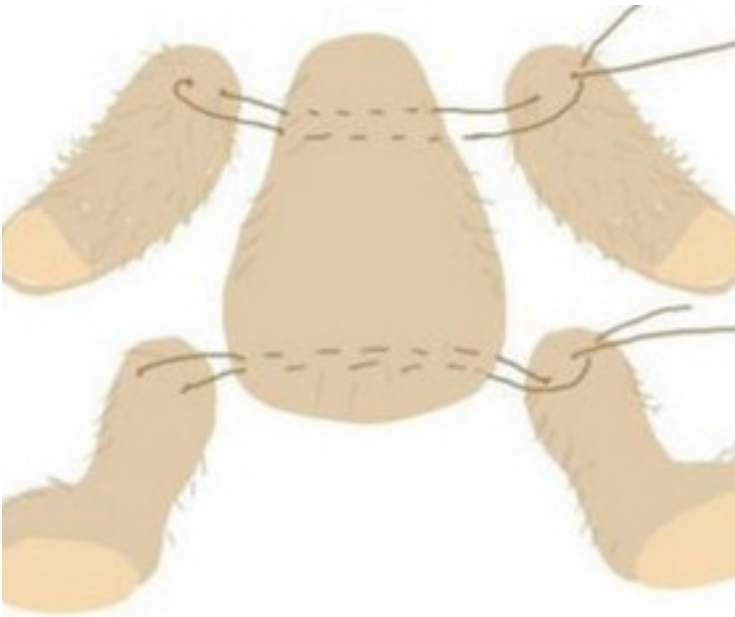


Next, sew the eyes. Take black sewing thread folded twice and a needle. Choose the location of the eyes on your own.



Embroider lashes near eyes with same thread and above eyes - eyebrows.

Embroider 3 stripes on the elephant's trunk.



Hind legs will be sewed with thread joint as shown on the picture.

Take very thick and strong thread, you can fold it in half, and long sewing needle. You can go through with the elephant's details several times (3-4), not once as shown in the picture. After each time try to pull up the thread.

Do not pull the thread through the leg to the outside, just grab a part.

Tighten the strands in the end so that the hind leg doesn't hang out, and tie into the knots several times. Hide yarn tails inside the body.

Place front legs on the sides of the body.  
Secure them with pins.



Sew them to the body.



Sew cone cap to the head previously  
stuff it with fiber and secure on the  
head with pins.

# SKIRT TAILORING



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Take following pieces of fabric:

Main fabric 12 cm x 25 cm/4,7 in x 9,8 in

For frills (2 pcs) 6,5 cm x 50 cm/2,6 in x 19,7 in

Bend about 2 cm/0,7 inches in the bottom of main fabric and stitch it.

Sew sides of main fabric.

Finish bottom edges of both frills in any technique you like (zig-zag, blanket stitch etc.) About 0,5 cm/ 0,2 in from the top of each frill make wide stitches along the entire length. You can do it on sewing machine or by hands.



Pull thread to the length of main part of the skirt. Fix the frill with knots. Distribute folds evenly along the entire length of the frill and stitch ones more with smaller stitches to secure folds. Sew sides of frills as well.

Draw lines for sewing frills on main fabric:

Top frill will be sewed on the distance 1 cm/0,4 in from the top of main fabric.

Bottom frill will be sewed on the distance 5 cm/1,96 in from the top of the main fabric.



Pin ready skirt to crochet top of the dress on the body and sew them together with the thread same shade as the yarn.





# CROCHET DRESS



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In **R16** of the body crocheted on the back loop, start to crochet bottom frill of the dress. Work with **Pink** color yarn counterclockwise turning the top of the body towards you.

**R1:** ch 3, 48 dc Inc (make Inc in each stitch), sl st to join (96)

**R2-9 (7 rounds):** ch 3, 96 dc, sl st (96)

**R10:** ch 1, 96 sc, sl st (96)



In **R21** of the body crocheted on the back loop, start to crochet top frill with **Pink** color yarn. Work counterclock-wise turning the top of the body towards you.

**R1:** ch 3, 42 dc Inc (make Inc in each st), sl st (84).

**R2-7 (6 rounds):** ch 3, 84 dc, sl st (84).

**R8:** ch 1, 84 sc, sl st (84).



In **R24** of the body crocheted on the back loop, crochet blouse with **Lilac** color yarn. Work counterclock-wise turning the top of the body towards you.

**R1-4:** ch 1, 36 sc, sl st to join.





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
