

# Gingerbread Girl

## Amigurumi Crochet Pattern



#### Pattern:

Gingerbread Girl amigurumi crochet pattern is created by Little Bamboo Handmade (Designed by TS Min). The finished size for the doll is 32 cm. Please note that this size may vary depends on the yarn and crochet hook size used.

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#### **Materials:**

- 4 Ply Acrylic / Milk Cotton Yarn
- Light peach - White
- Khaki brown

- Light purple
- Dark purple
- Watermelon red

- Fiberfill or cotton
- Crochet hook size 2 mm
- Wire
- Black safety eye 9 mm
- Hook and eye (4 sets)
- Red and green buttons 12 mm
- Purple beads 7 mm (2)

#### **Abbreviations:**

ch - chain

sc – single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

dec – decrease

inc - increase

dc-inc - double crochet increase

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sc3tog - single crochet 3 together
sl st - slip stitch
sk st - skip stitch
FLO - front loop only
BLO - back loop only
[] repeat work as directed
() number of stitches you should have at the end of your round
FO - finish off
MR - magic ring
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## Arm (Make 2)

With light peach colour yarn,

Rnd 1 : 6 sc in MR (6)

Rnd 2 : 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 1 sc (8)

Rnd 3-5 : 8 sc around (8)

Rnd 6 : 4 dec (4)

Rnd 7 : 4 sc around (4)

Rnd 8 : 1 sc, inc, 2 sc (5)

Rnd 9 : 5 sc around (5)

Rnd 10 : 2 sc, inc, 2 sc (6)

Rnd 11-12: 6 sc around (6)

Rnd 13 : 2 sc, inc, 3 sc (7)

Rnd 14-15: 7 sc around (7)

Rnd 16 : 3 sc, dec, 2 sc (6)

Rnd 17 : 2 sc, dec, 2 sc (5)

Rnd 18-19: 5 sc around (5)

Rnd 20 : 2 sc, inc, 2 sc (6)

Rnd 21-25: 6 sc around (6), FO.



## Leg (Make 2)

With white colour yarn,

Rnd 1 : 5 sc in MR (5)

Rnd 2 : [1 sc, inc] repeat 2 times, 1 sc (7)

Rnd 3-4 : 7 sc around (7)

Rnd 5 : 2 inc, 5 sc (9)

Rnd 6 : 1 sc, 2 inc, 6 sc (11)

Rnd 7 : 1 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc (9)

Rnd 8 : 2 dec, 5 sc (7)

Rnd 9 : dec, 5 sc (6)

Rnd 10-12: 6 sc around (6)

Rnd 13 : 1 sc, inc, 4 sc (7)

Rnd 14 : 2 sc, inc, 4 sc (8)

Rnd 15 : 3 sc, inc, 4 sc (9)

Rnd 16 : 4 sc, inc, 4 sc (10)

Rnd 17 : (BLO) 10 sc around (10)

Change to light peach colour yarn,

Rnd 18-19: 10 sc around (10)

Rnd 20 : 5 sc, dec, 3 sc (9)

Rnd 21 : 4 sc, dec, 3 sc (8)

Rnd 22 : 3 sc, dec, 3 sc (7)

Rnd 23 : 7 sc around (7)

Rnd 24 : 1 sc, inc, 5 sc (8)

Rnd 25 : 1 sc, dec, 5 sc (7)

Rnd 26 : 4 sc, inc, 2 sc (8)



Rnd 27 : 5 sc, inc, 2 sc (9)

Rnd 28 : 6 sc, inc, 2 sc (10)

Rnd 29 : 7 sc, inc, 2 sc (11)

Rnd 30 : 8 sc, inc, 2 sc (12)

Rnd 31 : 9 sc, inc, 2 sc (13)

Rnd 32 : 10 sc, inc, 2 sc (14)

Rnd 33-37: 14 sc around (14), FO.

With feet facing you, attach white colour yarn and work on front loop of Rnd 17,

Rnd 17b : ch 1, [1 sc, 3 hdc in same st] repeat 5 times, join. FO.

## To Join The Legs, Body and head

Place both legs side by side with the back of the leg facing you. Put the wire into both legs. (Wire for body frame: Cut 60 cm wire, fold half and form a big loop at the top and 2 small loops at both ends)



Find the middle point on the inside of the legs, attach khaki brown yarn on right leg,

Rnd 1 : ch 2, 14 sc (left leg), 2 sc (on ch), 14 sc (right leg), 2 sc (on ch) (32)

Rnd 2-4 : 32 sc around (32)

Rnd 5 : dec, 28 sc, dec (30)

Rnd 6 : dec, 26 sc, dec (28)

Change to light peach colour yarn,

Rnd 7 : dec, 24 sc, dec (26)

Rnd 8 : dec, 22 sc, dec (24)

Rnd 9 : dec, 20 sc, dec (22)

Rnd 10 : dec, 18 sc, dec (20)

Rnd 11 : dec, 16 sc, dec (18)

Rnd 12 : dec, 14 sc, dec (16)

Rnd 13 : dec, 12 sc, dec (14)

Rnd 14-15: 14 sc around (14)

Rnd 16 : inc, 12 sc, inc (16)


Rnd 17 : 5 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 5 sc (18)

Rnd 18 : 5 sc, 2 inc, 4 sc, 2 inc, 5 sc (22)

Rnd 19 : 22 sc around (22)

Rnd 20 : dec, 18 sc, dec (20)

Continue to join arms to body,



Rnd 22-23: 32 sc around (32)

Rnd 24 : 2 sc, sk 10 sts, 8 sc, sk 10 sts, 2 sc (12), stuff and sew close the 2 opening on the shoulders







Rnd 25 : 6 dec (6)

Rnd 26-27: 6 sc around (6)

Rnd 28 : [2 sc, inc] repeat 2 times (8)

Continue to make the head,

Rnd 29 : (FLO) 8 inc (16)

Rnd 30 : [1 sc, inc] repeat 8 times (24)

Rnd 31 : [2 sc, inc] repeat 8 times (32)

Rnd 32 : [ 3 sc, inc ] repeat 8 times ( 40 )

Rnd 33 : [4 sc, inc] repeat 8 times (48)

Rnd 34-44: 48 sc around (48)

Rnd 45 : [ 3 sc, dec, 3 sc ] repeat 6 times (42)

Rnd 46 : [5 sc, dec] repeat 6 times (36)


Rnd 47 : [ 2 sc, dec, 2 sc ] repeat 6 times ( 30 )

Rnd 48 : [ 3 sc, dec ] repeat 6 times (24)

Rnd 49 : [ 1 sc, dec, 1 sc ] repeat 6 times (18)

Rnd 50 : [ 1 sc, dec ] repeat 6 times ( 12 )

Rnd 51 : 6 dec (6), FO.



#### Hair

With light purple colour yarn,

Rnd 1 : 6 sc in MR ( 6 )

Rnd 2 : 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3 : (BLO) [1 sc, inc] repeat 6 times (18)

Rnd 4 : sl st, [ ch 30, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 29 sl sts, sl st to next st, ch 30, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 29 sl sts, ch 30, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 29 sl sts, sl st to next st ] repeat 9 times ( 27 strands of hair )

Rnd 5 : ( work on front loop of Rnd 3 ) [ ch 40, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 39 sl sts, sl st to next st] repeat 3 times, [ ch 50, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 45 inc, 4 sl sts, sl st to next st] repeat 3 times, [ ch 32, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 31 sl sts, sl st to next st] repeat 3 times, [ ch 50, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 45 inc, 4 sl sts, sl st to next st] repeat 3 times ( 12 strands of hair ), FO.



Attach eyes between Rnd 38-40, 6 sts apart from each other. Then, use black thread to embroider eyebrow and eyelashes. With light peach colour yarn and watermelon red colour yarn to embroider nose and mouth.



Place the hair on the head with the 3 longer strands of hair from Rnd 5 at the front. Glue the strands of hair from Rnd 4 and the 3 shorter hair from Rnd 5 neatly around the head.



Then, curl the 3 strands of longer hair from Rnd 5 and glue them on the forehead as shown in picture. Place the curly hair at both side of the head.



#### Shoe (make 2)

With dark purple colour yarn,

Rnd 1 : ch 8, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 6 sc, 3 sc in last ch, work on opposite side,

5 sc, 2 sc in last st, join (16)

Rnd 2 : ch 1, inc, 6 sc, 3 sc in same st, 8 sc, join (19)

Change to light purple colour yarn,

Rnd 3 : (BLO) ch 1, 19 sc around, join (19)

Rnd 4 : ch 1, 8 sc, sc3tog, 8 sc, join (17)

Rnd 5 : ch 1, 8 sc, dec, 7 sc, join (16)

Rnd 6 : 5 sl st, ch 6, sk 7 sts, 4 sl st, join (14), FO. Glue on the purple bead.



## **Blouse**

With white colour yarn,

Row 1 : ch 19, start from 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, [5 sc, inc] repeat 3 times, turn (21)

Row 2 : ch 1, [2 sc, inc] repeat 7 times, turn (28)

Row 3 : ch 1, 4 sc, 6 inc, 8 sc, 6 inc, 4 sc, turn (40)

Row 4 : ch 1, 4 sc, ch 4, sk 11 st, 10 sc, ch 4, sk 11 st, 4 sc, turn (26)

Row 5 : ch 1, 6 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 6 sc, turn (24)

Row 6 : ch 1, 5 sc, dec, 10 sc, dec, 5 sc, turn (22)

Row 7-13: ch 1, 22 sc, turn (22), FO.





## **Sleeve**

Attach white colour yarn at the place of the sleeve hole as shown in picture,

Rnd 1-2 : ch 1, 17 sc, join (17)

Rnd 3 : ch 1, 8 sc, 2 dec, 5 sc, join (15)

Rnd 4 : ch 2, 15 dc-inc, join (30), FO. Repeat the same for the other sleeve.

Then sew on 2 sets of hook and eye at the back of the blouse.



#### **Dress**

With khaki brown colour yarn, ch 3 is counted as 1 dc

Row 1 : ch 31, start from  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook, 30 sc, turn (30)

Row 2-4 : ch 1, 30 sc, turn (30)

Row 5 : ch 1, [14 sc, inc] repeat 2 times, turn (32)

Row 6-7 : ch 1, 32 sc, turn (32)

Row 8 : ch 1, [15 sc, inc] repeat 2 times, turn (34)

Row 9-10 : ch 1, 34 sc, turn (34)

Row 11 : ch 1, [16 sc, inc] repeat 2 times, join (36)

Starting from here onwards, work in rounds.

Row 12 : ch 3, 1 dc, dc-inc, [ 2 dc, dc-inc ] repeat 11 times, join (48)

Row 13 : (FLO) ch 3, 2 dc, dc-inc, [3 dc, dc-inc] repeat 11 times, join (60)

Row 14 : ch 1, 60 sc around, join (60), FO.

Attach watermelon red colour yarn to back loop of Row 13,

Row 13b : ch 3, 47 dc, join (48)

Row 14b : ch 3, dc in same st, 47 dc-inc, join (96)

Row 15b : ch 3, dc in same st, 95 dc-inc, join (192), FO.



Attach khaki brown colour yarn at top right corner and work on the top part,

Row 1 : ch 1, 5 sc, ch 15, sk 5 sts, 10 sc, ch 15, sk 5 sts, 5 sc, FO.



With white colour yarn, make ch 120 and glue it on the dress as shown in picture. Then, sew on 2 sets of hook and eye at the back of the dress and sew on the red and green buttons at the front.
