Crochet Amigurumi Patterns by Ildika Struning

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Materials

- Yarn/wool: I have used Catanía yarn from Schachenmayr in grey (0199), white, black, light green, dark green, light pink, for the egg red and white, for the basket mustard yellow (0214).
- Crochet hook: 3.0 mm
- Approx. 120 cm of single core copper PVC electrical wire (diameter: 3 mm)
- Rubber tape (electrician's tape) 1,5 cm wide to secure wire ends
- Tapestry needle
- Filling
- Scissors
- Pliers for cutting wire
- Optional: 2 small pebbles (diagonal: 1,5 cm) to make the two feet heavy
- Fishing line (approx.. 50 cm for whiskers)

Abbreviations

St(s) - stítch(es)

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Inc - íncrease (2 sc ín next st)

Dec - decrease (2 sc worked off together)

(nr) - indicates the total number of stitches in the current row/round

FO - fasten off

Important Notes

- All rounds are worked in a continuous spiral. Do not join or turn, unless instructed otherwise
- · You may find it useful to use a stitchmarker for counting your rounds
- Take your time to create your amigurumi's face, it is a very important part of the final result
- While stuffing and making the wire frame take care to give each part a nice shape

Size of finished figure

Funny Bunny is approximately 34cm tall.

The wire for the legs will later go through the holes just created. Treat the ch 2 loops in next round as normal stitches:

Round 60. $(sc, dec)^*$ (12)









Start to create the wire frame at this point. In my case the wire for the body was approximately 22cm long. Keep in mind the size of the hook and the gauge of the yarn you are using. You may want to leave the wire rather a bit longer. Adjust it to the final length, when the body's size is evident.

Make a loop at one end of the wire. Secure it with the rubber tape. Insert the wire into the body as you see on the picture. Make a loop with the wire in the head, secure the wire loop with rubber tape and start stuffing the head around the wire. Stuff the body (stuff nicely around the wire).

Cut the wire for the feet and legs (Approx. 50cm long. You may want to leave it a little longer as the exact size can be adjusted later.). Lead the leg's wire through the 2 holes and the bottom wire loop of the body.

FO. Close the hole by leading the thread through the front loops of last round, pull it tight and weave the yarn tail into the body.

Sweater Neck and Waist

Crochet 12 sc around the neck of Funny Bunny using the front loops of Round 34.

Crochet 42 sc around the waist of Funny Bunny using the front loops of Round 53. (See pictures)







Eyes



Eyeballs are crocheted in one piece.

With black yarn embroider the pupils on the eyeballs. The 2 pupils are placed in the \mathcal{F}^{th} round 2 stitches away from each other. Stuff the head through the eye opening. With invisible stitches and grey yarn sew the eyes into the head. For the exact place see the pictures above.

With 2-3 stitches separate the 2 eyeballs from each other as you see on the picture below:



Nose and Face

With light pink:

Round 2.

FO. Leave a long yarn tail. Close the hole by leading the thread through the front loops of last round, pull it tight. With invisible stitches sew it to the head.







Embroider the mouth with the light pink yarn tail - you can see Funny Bunny's sad and happy face on the pictures below.





Whiskers

Create the whiskers with fishing line. I made a loop behind the nose in the middle of each whisker, so they may not be pulled out.

Ears



With grey yarn:

Round 1.	6 sc in double adjustable ring	(6)

Round 3.	(2 sc, inc)*	(12)

FO; leave a long yarn tail. Flatten the ears and fold about a quarter of them back (see pictures above). With invisible stitches sew it to the head. See the pictures for the exact place.











Feet and legs

Stuff the knee softly.

FO. Leave a long yarn tail for sewing it to the body.



Legs of trousers with dark green (make 2):

Round 1.	15 sc in double adjustable ring (do not pull it tight)	(15)
Round 2.	sc *	(15)
Round 3.	sc * in front loops	(15)
Round 4.	- Round 14. sc*	(15)

FO; Leave a long yarn tail for sewing it to the body. Pull the trouser leg onto the leg (see pictures above).

Insert the wire into the legs. Pull it in carefully so that the knee stuffing remains in its place.


If you want to make the feet heavier, put the pebble at this point into the foot. This way Funny Bunny can stand easier.



Create the foot loop at the end of the leg's wire as you see on the picture below. It should fit into the foot. Secure the loop with rubber tape. Put the foot on the wire frame.







Round 21. 5 sc, ch 2 (this opening has to surround the leg's wire, see pictures), skip 1 stitch, 9 sc (16)







Stuff the foot nicely around the wire (and pebble).

Round 22. 5 sc, sc in the ch 2 loop from last round, g sc (15) Round 23. (sc, dec) 3-times, 6 sc (12)

Round 24. dec^* (6)

FO. Close the hole by leading the thread through the front loops of last round, pull it tight and weave the yarn tail into the foot.

Sew the leg to the foot and body with invisible stitches using the grey yarn tails left on the leg. With the green yarn tail sew the trousers' leg to the body. The trouser can be folded back easily at Round 3 (front loops).

Make the other leg and foot the same way. The length of the wire can be adjusted at this point.



Hands and Arms

Cut some wire for the arms and hands. Insert the wire through the corresponding holes on the body. The wire should reach the ground at the bunny's feet while standing in an upright position (see picture). In my case the wire was approx. 45 cm long.

Round 30. (2 sc, inc)2-times, 4 sc

Round 33. Right arm: Take the thumb, 3 sc (insert hook through the thumb and palm stitches), 2 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 4 sc

Left arm: sc, take the thumb, 3 sc (insert hook through the thumb and palm stitches), sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 4 sc (18)









Round 34. Right arm: 3 sc in front part of the thumb, 3 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 4 sc

Left arm: sc, 3sc in front part of thumb, 2 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 4 sc (20)

Round 35. - Round 37. sc* (20)

Round 38. (6 sc, dec) 2-times, 4 sc (18)

Round 39. sc^* (18)

With light green yarn crochet 8 sc around the arm into the front loops of round 7.







Insert the arm's wire into the arm. Create a loop as you see on the picture below. Adjust the length of the wire and secure the end with rubber tape. Stuff the hand (stuff it nicely around the wire). Keep on stuffing while crocheting.

FO. Close the hole by leading the yarn tail through the front loops of last round, pull it tight and weave the yarn tail into the hand.





Sew the arm to the body with the white yarn tail.

FO. Close the hole by leading the thread through the front loops of the last row, pull it tight and put the yarn tail into the egg.

Embroider the egg with white yarn.

Row 2.	Starting at 2 nd stitch from hook: 20 sc	(20)

FO. Leave a long yarn tail and sew the straps to the basket with invisible stitches.
