


Valentine Bookmark

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Skill Level:





Materials

- Yarn/wool: I have used Catania yarn from Schachenmayr in dark red (0192 < 50g), white (0106 < 50g), red (0115 < 50g) and beige (0263 < 50g) color.
- Crochet hook: 3.0 mm
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Filling
- Two 6 mm black safety eyes
- 20 cm long, 3 cm wide black elastic band

Abbreviations

St(s) - stitch(es)

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Slst - slip stitch

Inc - increase (2 sc in next st)

Dec - decrease (2 sc worked off together)

(nr) - indicates the total number of stitches in the current row/round

FO - fasten off

Important Notes

- All rounds are worked in a continuous spiral (except eyelids). Do not join or turn, unless instructed otherwise
- You may find it useful to use a stitchmarker for counting your rounds
- Take your time to create your amigurumi's face, it is a very important part of the final result
- While stuffing take care to give each part a nice shape

Size of finished figure

The Valentine bookmark is approximately 33 cm long.



Realization

Heart



First part with dark red yarn:

Round 1.	6 sc in doubl	le adjustable ring	(6)
Round 2.	inc*		(12)
Round 3.	(sc, inc)*		(18)
Round 4.	(2 sc, inc)*		(24)
Round 5.	- Round 9.	SC*	(24)

FO and weave in the yarn end.





Second part with dark red yarn:

Round 1.	6 sc in double adjustable ring	(6)		
Round 2.	inc*	(12)		
Round 3.	(sc, inc)*	(18)		
Round 4.	(2 sc, inc)*	(24)		
Round 5.	- Round 8. sc*	(24)		
In next round the two pieces are crocheted together (see pictures above):				
Round 9.	21 sc, align the first part with this one, insert hook through first and			
	second part stitches: 3 sc	(24)		
Round 10.	42 sc around (= 21 sc in free remaining stitches of first part, 21 sc in			
	free remaining stitches of second part)	(42)		

Crochet 1 sc and move your stitch marker to this point. The starting points of the upcoming rounds are shifted this way.



Round 11.	(19 sc, dec)*	(40)
Round 12.	(18 sc, dec)*	(38)
Round 13.	(17 sc, dec)*	(36)
Round 14.	(4 sc, dec)*	(30)
Round 15.	(3 sc, dec)*	(24)
Round 16.	(10 sc, dec)*	(22)
Round 17.	SC*	(22)

FO. Leave a long yarn tail for sewing it to the elastic band. Stuff the heart, insert the elastic band into the opening. Close the opening with invisible stitches (use the loops of the last round) and sew in the elastic band together with it (as you see on the pictures below).









Eyes







Eyeballs with white yarn (make 2):

Round 1. ch 4 (4)

Round 2. sc in second ch from hook, sc, 3 sc in last ch. Continue on the other

side of beginning ch: sc, 2 sc into the last ch (you made the first sc into

this ch) (8) Round 3. sc^*

FO. Leave a long yarn tail for sewing it to the heart.

Eyelids with red yarn (make 2):

Eyelids are crocheted in rows.

Row 1. ch7 (7)
Row 2. Starting at second ch from hook: 6 sc, turn (6)
Row 3. 3 dec, DO NOT TURN! (3)

Slst around. FO. Leave a long yarn tail.

Insert the black safety eyes into the eyeballs (see pictures above). With invisible stitches sew the eyes to the head. For the exact place see the pictures below.

Sew the eyelids onto the eyeballs.







With black yarn embroider the eyelashes and mouth.



Beige Tail End





With beige yarn:

Round 1. ch 10 (10)

Round 2. sc in second ch from hook, 7 sc (=sc in each of the next 7 ch), 3 sc in last ch. Continue on the other side of beginning ch: 7 sc (= sc in each of the next 7 ch), 2 sc into the last ch (you made the first sc into this ch) (20)

Round 3. - Round 6. sc* (20)

FO. Leave a long yarn tail and with invisible stitches sew it to the other end of the elastic band (see pictures above).

Feet





Bigger feet with beige yarn (make 2):

First toe:

Round 1. 4 sc in double adjustable ring (4) Round 2. sc* (4)

FO.

Second and third toe (thus make 2):

Round 1. 5 sc in double adjustable ring (5) Round 2. - Round 3. sc* (5)


FO.

Fourth toe:

Round 1. sc in double adjustable ring (6)
Round 2. – Round 3. sc* (6)



Do not fasten off, but continue crocheting the foot as follows.







Round 4. Right foot: sc in next 3 st of the fourth toe, sc in next 3 st of the third toe, sc in next 3 st of the second toe, sc in all 4 st of the first toe, sc in next 2 st of the second toe, sc in next 2 st of the third toe, sc in the last 3 remaining st of the fourth toe

Left foot: sc in next 3 st of the fourth toe, sc in next 2 st of the third toe, sc in next 2 st of the second toe, sc in all 4 st of the first toe, sc in next 3 st of the second toe, sc in next 3 st of the third toe, sc in the last

4 remaining st of the fourth toe	(20)
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Round 5. Right foot: 10 sc, dec, 6 sc, dec

Left foot: dec, 6 sc, dec, 10 sc (18)

Round 6. – Round 7. sc^* (18)

Round 8. $(4 \text{ sc, dec})^*$ (15)

Round 9. – Round 13. sc^* (15)

Stuff the foot. Take care to give it a nice shape.

FO. Close the hole by leading the thread through the front loops of last round, pull it tight and weave the yarn tail into the foot.

The second two smaller feet are crocheted similarly. Just skip Round 3 on the second and third toe and Round 13, as well.

With invisible stitches sew the feet to the beige tail end. See pictures for exact place and position.
