

# JUMPV

## WHAT YOU NEED

#### MATERIALS

80 g of grey cotton yarn - Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color 096 Shark Grey

A small amount of light grey cotton yarn - Yarn and Colors Must-Have Mini, color 095 Soft Grey

12 g of light pink cotton yarn - Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color 043 Pearl

10 g of pink cotton yarn - Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color 045 Blossom

A small amount of black cotton yarn - Yarn and Colors Must-Have, color 100 Black

A pair of safety eyes, 6 mm Stuffing Crochet hook, size. 2.5 mm

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Stitch (sts) Slip stitch (sl st) Chain stitch (ch) Single crochet (sc) Decrease  $(2 \rightarrow 1)$ Increase (2i1) Round (R)

Jumpy will measures approx. 22 cm in height and 30 cm with his ears stretched.





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## JUMPY

#### BODA

• grey yarn Stuff as you go R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts R2: (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts R3: (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts R4-5: sc around= 18 sts R6: (7 sc, 2 $\rightarrow$ 1) x 2 = 16 sts R7-8: sc around= 16 sts R9: (6 sc, 2 $\rightarrow$ 1) x 2 = 14 sts R10-11: sc around= 14 sts R12: (5 sc, 2 $\rightarrow$ 1) x 2 = 12 sts R13-14: sc around= 12 sts Break the yarn. Crochet the second leg without breaking the yarn and continue crocheting the body.

Chain 3. Insert your hook in any stitch on the first leg. Crochet around that leg and continue by crocheting around both the chain stitches and the legs.

#### CONTINUE WITH THE BODY

**R15:** 12 sc, 1 sc in each of the 3 ch, 12 sc, 1 sc in each of the 3 ch = 30 sts **R16:** sc around= 30 sts **R17:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts **R18-23:** sc around= 36 sts **R24:** (4 sc,  $2 \rightarrow 1$ ) x 6 = 30 sts **R25-26:** sc around= 30 sts Finish with a slip stitch and break the yarn.

#### HEAD

#### • grey yarn

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R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts
R2: (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts
R3: (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts
R4: (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts
R5: (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts
R6: (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts
R7: (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts
R8: (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts
R9: (7 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 54 sts
R10: (8 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 60 sts
R11: (9 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 66 sts
R12: (10 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 72 sts
R13: (11 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 78 sts
R14: (12 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 84 sts
R15: (13 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 90 sts
R16: (14 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 96 sts
R17: sc around= 96 sts
R18: (15 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 102 sts
R19-36: sc around= 102 sts
Insert your safety eyes at this point.
Place them between round 32 and 33
with a 20-sc gap between them.
R37: (15 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 96 sts
R38: sc around= 96 sts
R39: (14 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \ge 6 = 90 \text{ sts}
R40: (13 sc, 2→1) x 6 = 84 sts
R41: (12 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 78 sts
R42: (11 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 72 sts
R43: (10 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 66 sts
R44: (9 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 60 sts
R45: (8 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 54 sts
R46: (7 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 48 sts
R47: (6 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 42 sts
R48: (5 sc, 2 \rightarrow 1) x 6 = 36 sts
R49: (4 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \ge 6 = 30 \text{ sts}
Finish with a slip stich. Break the yarn,
leaving a long tail for assembling.
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#### ARMS (MAKE 2)

• grey yarn R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts R2: (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts R3-7: sc around= 12 sts Finish with a slip stich. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembling.

#### EARS (MAKE 2)

· grey yarn **R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts R2: (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts R3: sc around= 12 sts **R4:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts R5: sc around= 18 sts **R6:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts **R7-16:** sc around= 24 sts **R17:** (10 sc,  $2 \rightarrow 1$ ) x 2 = 22 sts **R18-20:** sc around= 22 sts **R21:** (9 sc,  $2 \rightarrow 1$ ) x 2 = 20 sts R22-24: sc around= 20 sts **R25:**  $(8 \text{ sc}, 2 \rightarrow 1) \ge 2 = 18 \text{ sts}$ **R26-33:** sc around= 18 sts Finish with a slip stich. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembling.

#### SNOUT

light grey yarn
R1: 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts
R2: (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts
R3: (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts
R4: (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts
R5: (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts
R6: (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts
R7: (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts
R8: (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts
R9: (7 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 54 sts
Finish with a slip stich. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembling.

HEADPHONES (MAKE 2) · light pink yarn **R1:** 6 sc in a magic ring = 6 sts **R2:** (2i1) x 6 = 12 sts **R3:** (1 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 18 sts **R4:** (2 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 24 sts **R5:** (3 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 30 sts **R6:** (4 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 36 sts **R7:** (5 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 42 sts **R8:** (6 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 48 sts **R9:** (7 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 54 sts **R10:** (8 sc, 2i1) x 6 = 60 sts Change to pink yarn **R11-15:** sc around= 60 sts Finish with a slip stich. Break the yarn, leaving a long tail for assembling.

#### MIDDLE PIECE

black yarn
Chain 10 and join with a slip stitch to form a ring.
Crochet 1 sc around until the middle piece is long enough to reach from one headphone to the other.
Measure the middle piece on Jumpy's head to make sure it's long enough.
The headphones should be placed 18 rounds from the top of the head.
My middle piece ended up measuring 15-16 cm.



## ASSEMBLY 1

Pin the snout on the head and sew it, approx. 27 rounds below the top of the head.

On the snout, embroider a big nose with light pink yarn and a line with black yarn from the bottom of the nose to the bottom of the snout.

If you prefer, you can also embroider the nose before sewing the snout on the head.

### 2

Stuff the head and sew the head and body together. Stuff the neck firmly to make sure the head won't dangle.

Stuff the arms and sew them to each side of the body, 3 rounds below the neck.

Place the black middle piece across the head and sew it's ends to the head. Pin the headphones to each side of the head and sew them, approx. 18 rounds below the top of the head. Stuff the headphones before sewing them all the way around.



Pin the ears on top of the head, folding them at the base. Sew them 7 rounds below the top of the head.
