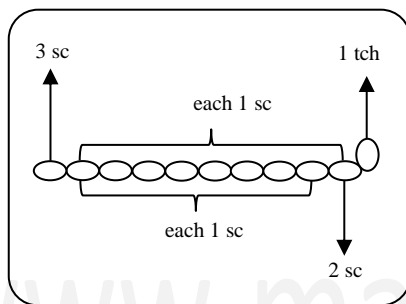
Head

The head of the lucky dragon kid will be crocheted with yarn in the indicated yarn color and with the crochet hook size 2. During crocheting wird der Kopf will be evenly stuffed with stuffing resp. fibrefill.

Continuously crocheting in spiral rounds

- 10 ch, 1 tch
- 1 sc in the second last chain, 8 sc and 3 sc into the last ch,
(crochet the rest on the bottom side of the row of chains), 8 sc and 2 sc into the last stitch
= 22 sc



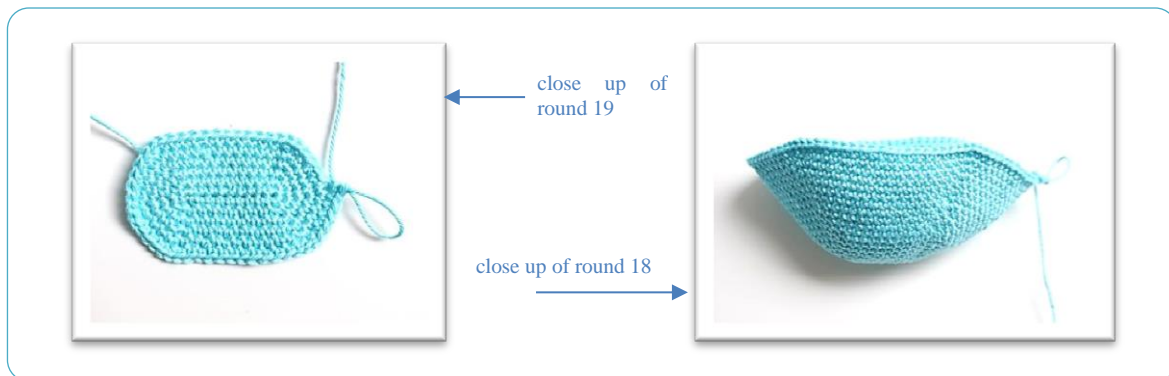
graphic depiction of round 2



close up of round 2

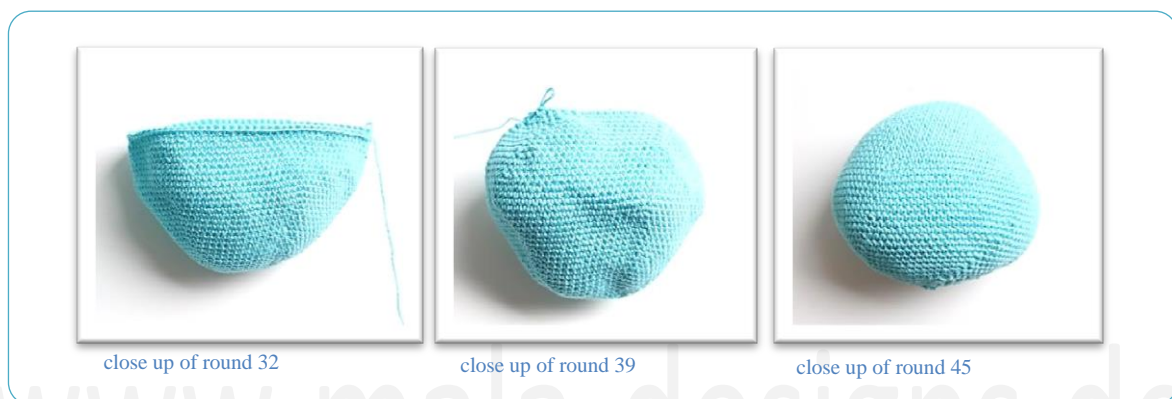

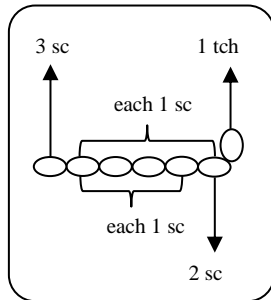
During sewing onto the head the muzzle will be stuffed with stuffing resp. fibrefill.

Continuously crocheting in spiral rounds

- 6 ch, 1 tch
- 1 sc in the second last chain, 4 sc and 3 sc into the last ch,

(crochet the rest on the bottom side of the row of chains), 4 sc and 2 sc into the last stitch

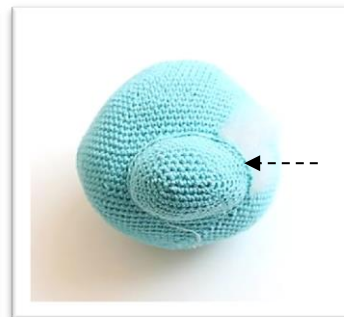

During crocheting the tongue won't be stuffed with stuffing resp. fibrefill.

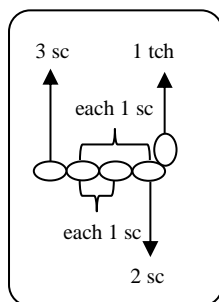

During crocheting the mouth won't be stuffed with stuffing resp. fibrefill.

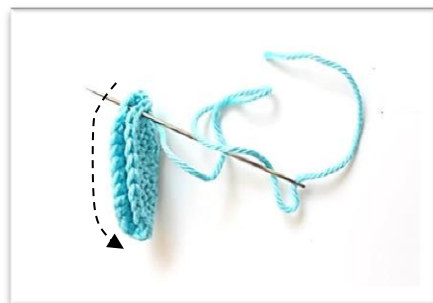

→ finally: sew the finished mouth to the muzzle – cf. fig. :

The nostrils will be crocheted with yarn in the indicated yarn color and with the crochet hook size 2.

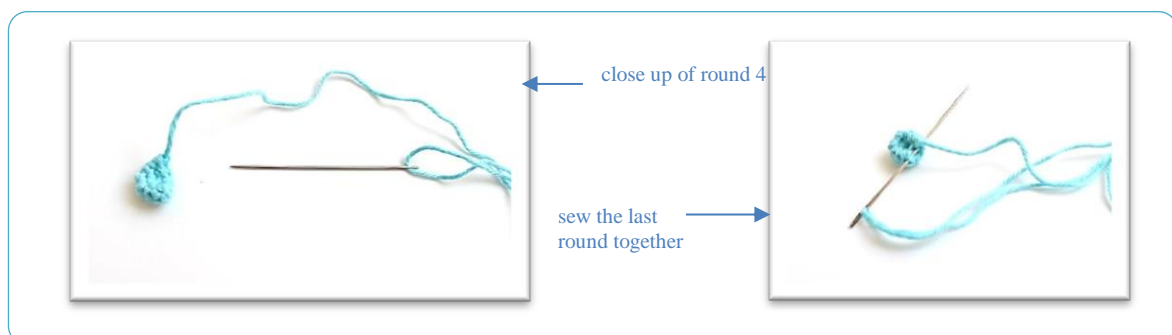
During crocheting the nostrils won't be stuffed with stuffing resp. fibrefill.

→ fasten off last sc; leaving a longer tail in order to sew the last round together – cf. fig. :

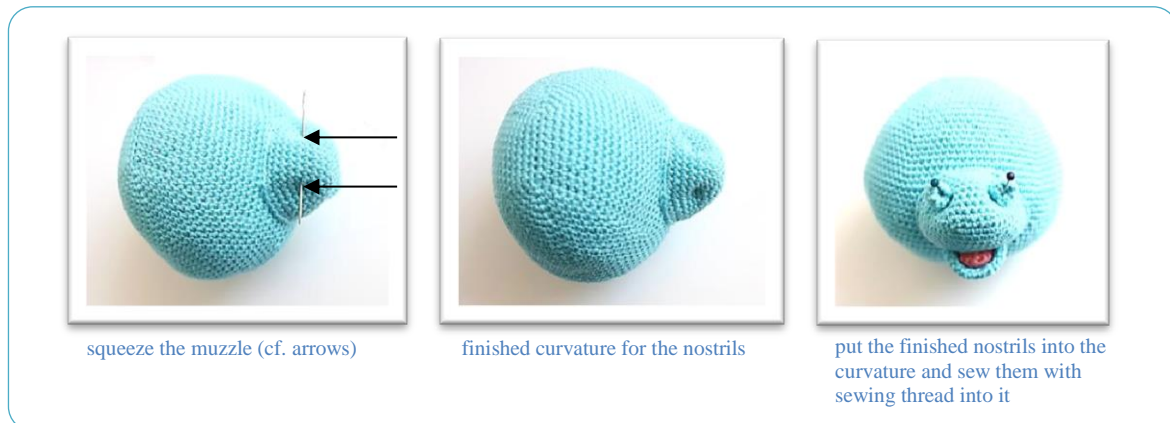


→ weave in yarn invisibly; the nostrils will be sewn onto the muzzle with sewing thread later

step in between: finalising the muzzle

- the holes for the nostrils will be prepared onto the muzzle:

- a) squeeze the muzzle (using the thumb and index finger) and form a curvature
- b) fix this position with a few stitches (entry point for needle you will see in the fig. and exit point being the other one on the opposite side) then weave in end of yarn invisibly – cf. fig.



- c) the nostrils will be placed into the curvatures and sewn on with sewing thread

Eyes (make 2)

The eyes of the lucky dragon kid will be crocheted with yarn in the indicated yarn color and with the crochet hook size 2. During crocheting the eyes won't be stuffed with stuffing resp. fibrefill.

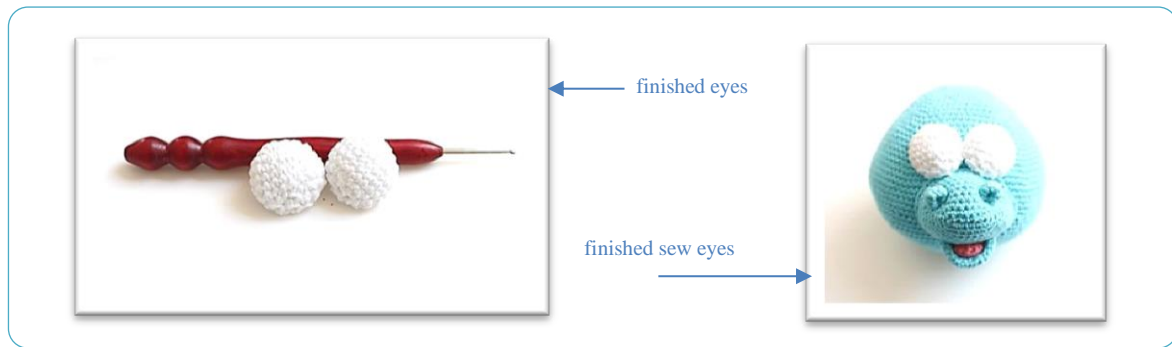
