### Crochet Pattern

#### Start Here...

- · Please, read the whole pattern through properly so you have a good overview.
- The baby is made up of the following parts:
  - · 1 Head with Hair, 1 Nose and 2 Ears (add 1 Bow and Earrings for girl version)
  - · 1 Body (with 2 Knots for Diaper)
  - · 2 Arms
  - · 2 Legs with Foot
  - · 1 T-shirt
- · The pacifier made up of the following parts:
  - · 2 Guards
  - · 1 Ring
  - · 1 Nipple
- · The baby bottle made up of the following parts:
  - · 1 Jar
  - · 1 Cap
  - · 1 Nipple
- · The teddy bear bib made up of the following parts:
  - 1 Bib
  - · 1 Nose
  - · 1 Snout
  - · 2 Ears
- · The teddy bear cocoon made up of the following parts:
  - · 1 Bag
  - · 1 Teddy Bear Base
  - · 1 Teddy Bear Snout
  - · 1 Teddy Bear Nose
  - · 2 Teddy Bear Ears
- · Measurements:
  - · Baby (height): 10.2 inches (26 cm).
  - · Pacifier: 2.7 inches (7 cm).
  - · Baby Bottle: 3.1 inches (8 cm).
  - · Teddy Bear Bib: 3.4x3.1 inches (9x8 cm).
  - · Teddy Bear Cocoon: 9 inches (23 cm).

#### Materials (materials to make all the accessories and two babies)

- · 4 mm crochet hook and 5 mm crochet hook.
- · Worsted Weight yarn: Beige (245 gr), Light Brown (45 gr), Brown (30 gr), Dark Brown (just a little), Pink (10 gr), White (55 gr), Red (30 gr), Light Pink (35 gr), Yellow or Orange (just a little), Turquoise (15 gr), Black (just a little).
- · Thread: Black (just a little), Yellow or Orange (just a little).
- · 4 Amigurumi Safety Eyes 15mm.
- · 1 Little Button (for t-shirt).
- · 2 Little Black Buttons (for teddy bear cocoon).
- · Cushion Stuffing.
- · Scissors & needle.

#### **Notes**

- · Most of the parts of this pattern are made using a 4mm crochet hook. Where a different hook is required will be specified in the pattern.
- · The ch and sl st are not included in the stitch count of each round.
- · Note that the orientation of all parts of the pattern are set looking at the project from the front.

#### **Glossary:**

sc: single crochet || ch: chain || sl st: slip stitch || dc: double crochet || hdc: half double crochet || sc2tog: sc decrease

### **Special Stitches**

#### 4-dc Cluster Stitch

- **1.** Yarn over, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook, leaving last 2 loops of this dc on the hook.
- **2.** Yarn over, insert hook in the same stitch, yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook, leaving last loop of this dc on the hook (there are now 3 loops on the hook).
- **3.** Yarn over, insert hook in same stitch, yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook, leaving last loop of this dc on the hook (there are now 4 loops on the hook).
- **4.** Yarn over, insert hook in the same stitch, yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch, yarn over, draw through 2 loops on hook, leaving last loop of this dc on the hook (there are now 5 loops on the hook).
- 5. Yarn over, pull loop through all loops on hook (this completes the cluster).

#### **French Knot**

- · To make a French Knot, bring your needle up through the piece where you want to place the knot. Wrap the yarn around the needle twice.
- · To finish the knot, insert the needle back into the piece close to the hole you came out of (almost in the same hole). Slowly pull the needle and working yarn through the wrapped loops to complete a French knot.

### **Generic Processes**

#### **Sew Edges**


It's an easy process. Just take your piece, flatten it, and sew the open edges closed. Depending on the pattern, you should fasten off or leave a long tail to sew it later.








#### **Hair Strand by Strand:**

- · With this process you will learn to make hairs strand by strand. Sometimes this process will be used to make other elements, such as a skirt, etc.
- · To make one hair, cut a piece of yarn, 3 inches (7.5 cm) in length. Insert the hook through one stitch (*figure 1*), yarn over, draw yarn through the stitch (*you've done a loop*) (*figure 2*), yarn over again (*with both strands*) and pull through the loop (*figure 3 & 4*). Repeat this process to make more hairs.
- · Finally, cut these hairs to the desired length.

#### **Baby**

#### **Head:**

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

      11 round: 1 sc in each sc (60 sts).
      12 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 5 sc * repeat 5 more times (66 sts).
13 to 18 round: 1 sc in each sc (66 sts, 6 rounds in total).
                  1 sc in next 33 sc, 4-dc cluster stitch in next sc, 1 sc in next 32 sc (66 sts).
      19 round:
20 to 22 round: 1 sc in each sc (66 sts. 3 rounds in total).
```

- · When you place the parts of the head, remember that you should place the cluster stitch forward. This is the nose.
- · I used amigurumi safety eyes for this pattern. Place them centered, between rounds 17 and 18. For your reference the eyes have a distance of 3 sts between them.

*Note:* If you don't want to use amigurumi safety eyes, you can do the eyes with stitches. With black yarn make several stitches for each eye. Place them in round 18. For your reference the eyes have a distance of 3 sts between them.

- · With hair color thread you can make two diagonal stitches above each eye, on round 14, to give it a more fun expression. The length of each stitch is about 2 stitches.
- For Girl version: to make the eyelashes, with black thread make 2 little stitches on the outer edge of each eye. Make the first stitch straight and the following a little leaning. The length of each stitch is about 1 stitch.
- · To make the freckles, with orange thread make several random little stitches under each eye, next to the nose.
- · Make 2 hairs with hair color yarn on Magic Ring of the head, following the instructions on page 3, in section "Hair Strand by Strand".
- · Now you must make and sew the ears. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation below.

23 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 5 sc * repeat 5 more times (60 sts).
24 round: * 1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (54 sts).
25 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 4 sc * repeat 5 more times (48 sts).
26 round: * 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (42 sts).
27 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 5 more times (36 sts).
28 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (30 sts).
29 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (24 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · To make the mouth, with black thread, do one diagonal stitch (1 st in length). Place the mouth on round 23. You can place a little to the right to make the expression more fun.
- · Make the small cheeks with rouge.
- · Stuff the head, fasten off and leave the head open.



Crochet Pattern

Ear: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 to 3 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 2 rounds in total).


4 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog \* repeat 3 more times (8 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that

piece later.

• For Girl version: to make the earring, with yellow yarn make one french knot on the ear, between round 3 and 4.

· Sew the edges of each ear following the instructions on page 3, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".

· Then sew the ears on both sides of the head, left and right, between rounds 14 and 18. Fasten off.





#### **Bow:** Only for Girl version

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With pink yarn do 22 ch. Join with sl st to form a ring.

1 round: 1 ch and 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next 21 ch (22 sts).

2 to 7 round: 1 sc in each sc (22 sts, 6 rounds more). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· To finish the bow, with pink yarn, pass a yarn around the center several times. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Sew the bow on top of the head, just in front of the hair. Fasten off.







### Crochet Pattern

#### **Body:**

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With white or light pink yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

3 round: \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).

4 round: \*1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc \* repeat 5 more times (30 sts).

**5 round:** \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

6 round: \*1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts).

7 round: 1 sc in each sc (42 sts).

8 round: \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (48 sts).

9 to 14 round: 1 sc in each sc (48 sts, 6 rounds in total).

15 round: \* 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (42 sts). Do not fasten off the white yarn. Leave the

yarn tail dangling on the outside of the work.

**16 round:** Work with the back loop only this round. Change to beige yarn. 1 sc in each sc (42 sts).

17 to 18 round: 1 sc in each sc (42 sts, 2 rounds in total).

19 round: \*1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 3 sc \* repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

20 to 21 round: 1 sc in each sc (36 sts, 2 rounds in total).

22 round: \* 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (30 sts).

23 to 24 round: 1 sc in each sc (30 sts, 2 rounds in total).

**25 round:** \* 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).

**26 to 27 round:** 1 sc in each sc (24 sts, 2 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · With the leftover white yarn of the body, surface sl st in each sc between rounds 15 and 16 (42 sts). Fasten off.
- To make the navel, with another piece of beige yarn, make several horizontal stitches, very small (3 sts in length), between rounds 16 and 17. Make these stitches leaving the beginning of the rounds in the back. Fasten off.

#### **Knot for Diaper:**

· Attach a new white or light pink yarn between rounds 12 and 13 of body, on 13th sc from the beginning of the round and do:

1 row: 1 sl st, 8 ch, 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 3 ch, 1 hdc in next 3 ch, 1 sl st in the same st,

1 sl st in next sc, 8 ch, 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 3 ch, 1 hdc in next 3 ch, 1 sl st in the

same st. Fasten off.

- · Tie a knot with both ends.
- · Attach a new white or light pink yarn between rounds 12 and 13 of body, on 35th sc from the beginning of the round and do:

1 row: 1 sl st, 8 ch, 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 3 ch, 1 hdc in next 3 ch, 1 sl st in the same st,

1 sl st in next sc, 8 ch, 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 3 ch, 1 hdc in next 3 ch, 1 sl st in the

same st. Fasten off.

 $\cdot$  Tie a knot with both ends.

#### Arm: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: \* 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (15 sts).

**3 to 6 round:** 1 sc in each sc (15 sts, 4 rounds in total).

7 round: \* 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 2 more times (12 sts).
8 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog \* repeat 3 more times (8 sts).

9 to 21 round: 1 sc in each sc (8 sts, 13 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · Stuff only the hand of the arm.
- · Sew the edges of each arm following the instructions on page 3, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".



Crochet Pattern

#### Leg: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 2 more times (9 sts).

2 to 12 round: 1 sc in each sc (9 sts, 11 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Stuff the leg.

#### Foot: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc. Join with sl st in first sc of Magic Ring.


1 round: 4 ch, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 1 sc in next 5 sc, working now in the opposite

side of the ch, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 2 sc in next ch. Move the beginning of the round to the next stitch

(12 sts).

2 to 5 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 4 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · Stuff the foot.
- · Place the leg upright with the foot (*leave the leg yarn up*). You must keep in mind that the two feet are different, right and left. To make them you must place the big toes on the inner sides of the legs.
- · Then sew the edge of the foot to the leg. Fasten off.



· Sew the edges of each leg following the instructions on page 3, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".

Crochet Pattern

#### **T-shirt**

#### Step 1:

· With turquoise yarn do 33 ch.

1 row: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (the first 2 ch count as first hdc), 1 hdc in next 30 ch, 1 ch and turn (32

sts).

2 row: 1 sc in next 5 hdc, 2 ch, skip next 5 hdc, 1 sc in next 12 hdc, 2 ch, skip next 5 hdc, 1 sc in next 5

hdc, 1 ch and turn (22 sts).

3 row: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 12 more times. You must work the ch from the previous

round. 1 ch and turn (39 sts).

4 to 7 row: 1 sc in each sc, 1 ch and turn (39 sts, 4 rows in total).

8 row: 1 sc in each sc (39 sts). Fasten off.

#### Step 2:

· Attach a new white yarn in first ch of foundation ch and do:

1 row: 1 ch + 1 sc in first ch, 5 ch + 1 sl st in the same ch (you have made a buttonhole), 1 sc in next 30 ch.

· Sew a small button on the opposite side where you made the buttonhole.




#### Finishing the Baby Amigurumi:


- · Sew the head to the body.
- · Sew the arms on both sides of the body, right and left, between rounds 25 and 26.
- · Then sew the legs on the bottom of the body. Place them centered, at the same level as the arms, with a separation between them of 4 sts.
- · Put the t-shirt on the baby.
- · Fasten off all yarns.

### **Pacifier**

#### Guard: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With pink yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.


1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts). Fasten off just one guard, and leave


a long tail on the second one.

· Place both pieces with wrong sides together (figure 5 & 6).

· Now insert the hook through both pieces and do 1 sl st in each sc (figure 7 & 8). Fasten off.









#### Ring:

· With pink or blue yarn do 12 ch.

1 row: 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sl st in next 10 ch (11 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing

that piece later.

· Sew both ends of the ring in the center of one side of the guard. Fasten off.

#### Nipple:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With white yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 to 3 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 2 rounds in total).

4 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog \* repeat 3 more times (8 sts).

5 round: \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog \* repeat one more time (6 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing

that piece later.

· Stuff the nipple a little and sew it on the empty side of the guard. Place it on the Magic Ring. Fasten off.

### **Teddy Bear Bib**

#### Bib - Step 1:

· This part is not worked continuously. With light brown yarn do 13 ch.

1 row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 11 ch, 1 ch and turn (12 sts).

2 row: 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 ch and turn (14 sts).

3 row: 1 sc in each sc, 1 ch and turn (14 sts).

4 row: 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 ch and turn (16 sts).

5 to 10 row: 1 sc in each sc, 1 ch and turn (16 sts, 6 rounds in total).

**11 row:** 1 sc in next 4 sc, 1 ch and turn (4 sts).

12 row: \* sc2tog \* repeat one more time, 1 ch and turn (2 sts).

13 row: 1 sc in next 2 sc, 1 ch and turn (2 sts).

14 row: sc2tog (1 st). Fasten off.

#### Bib - Step 2:

· Attach a new light brown yarn in 13th sc of row 10.

**11 row:** 1 sc in next 4 sc, 1 ch and turn (4 sts).

12 row: \* sc2tog \* repeat one more time, 1 ch and turn (2 sts).

13 row: 1 sc in next 2 sc, 1 ch and turn (2 sts).

14 row: sc2tog (1 st). Fasten off.

#### Bib - Step 3:

15 row: With a new piece of light brown yarn do 20 ch, (now you will work across the top of the bib) 1 sc in last

st of row 14 of Step 1, 1 sc in next ch, 1 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next ch, 1 sc in next 8 sc, 1 sc in first sc of row 11 of Step 2, 1 sc in next ch, 1 sc in first sc of row 13 of Step 2, 1 sc in next sc, 20 ch. Fasten off.

#### Nose:

· With dark brown yarn create a Magic Ring with 5 sc. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### **Snout:**

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn do 5 ch.

1 round: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 3 sc in next ch, working now in the opposite side of the

foundation ch, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 2 sc in next ch (do not count last ch) (10 sts).

2 round: 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc. Join with sl st

in first sc of this round (16 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### Ear: (x2)


· With light brown yarn create a Magic Ring with 10 hdc. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### **Finishing the Teddy Bear Bib:**

- $\cdot$  With beige yarn sew the snout on the bib. Place it centered, between rows 1 and 4.
- · With dark brown yarn sew the nose. Place it on the last round of the snout and row 6 of the bib. Then make a long stitch down, 1 st in length.
- · With black yarn make several stitches for each eye. Place them in row 7 of the bib. For your reference the eyes have a distance of 3 sts between them.
- $\cdot$  With light brown yarn sew the ears on the bib. Place them centered, between rows 9 and 10. For your reference the ears have a distance of 6 sts between them.







Crochet Pattern

### **Baby's Bottle**

#### Jar:

- · You must stuff the jar little by little as you crochet it, making the process easier.
- · Work this part continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With white yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

3 round: \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (24 sts).

**4 round:** Work with the back loop only this round. 1 sc in each sc (24 sts).

**5 to 11 round:** 1 sc in each sc (24 sts, 7 rounds in total).

**12 round:** \* 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

**13 round:** \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (12 sts).

**14 round:** \* sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (6 sts).

· Now using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close. Fasten off.

#### Cap:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With pink yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

**1 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times. Join with sl st (18 sts).

3 round: Work with the back loop only this round. 1 ch and 1 sc in the same st, 1 sc in next 17 sc (18 sts).

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### Nipple:

· Work this part continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn and create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.


1 to 2 round: 1 sc in each sc (6 sts, 2 rounds in total).

**3 round:** 2 sc in each sc (12 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · With beige yarn sew the nipple on top of the cap. Place it centered.
- · Then stuff the cap just a little and sew it on top of the jar. Place it centered.

## **Teddy Bear Cocoon**

#### Bag:

· Work this part in joined rounds. With red yarn and 5mm crochet hook create a Magic Ring with 2 ch (do not count as first hdc) + 10 dc. Join with sl st in top ch.

1 round: 2 ch (do not count as first dc), 2 dc in each dc. Join with sl st in top ch (20 sts).

2 round: 2 ch (do not count as first dc), \* 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc \* repeat 9 more times. Join with sl

st in top ch (30 sts).

3 round: 2 ch (do not count as first dc), \* 1 dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc \* repeat 9 more times. Join with

sl st in top ch (40 sts).

4 round: 2 ch (do not count as first dc), \* 1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next 2 dc \* repeat 9 more

times. Join with sl st in top ch (50 sts).

**5 to 9 round:** 2 ch (do not count as first dc), 1 dc in each dc. Join with sl st in top ch (50 sts).

10 to 18 round: Change to brown yarn. 2 ch (do not count as first dc), 1 dc in each dc. Join with sl st in top ch (50

sts). Fasten off.

#### **Teddy Bear Base:**

· Work this part continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With light brown and 5mm crochet hook yarn create a Magic Ring with 2 ch (count as first hdc) + 9 hdc.

1 round: 2 hdc in each hdc (20 sts).

2 round: \* 1 hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc \* repeat 9 more times (30 sts).

3 round: \* 1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc \* repeat 9 more times (40 sts).

4 round: \* 1 hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, 1 hdc in next 2 hdc \* repeat 9 more times (50 sts).

**5 round:** \* 1 hdc in next 4 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc \* repeat 9 more times (60 sts).

6 round: \* 1 hdc in next 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc, 1 hdc in next 3 hdc \* repeat 9 more times (70 sts).

7 round: 1 hdc in each hdc (70 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### **Teddy Bear Snout:**

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With beige yarn do 7 ch.

1 round: 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 ch count as first hdc), 1 hdc in next 3 ch, 5 hdc in next ch, working now

in the opposite side of the foundation ch, 1 hdc in next 3 ch, 3 hdc in next ch (16 sts).

2 round: 2 hdc in next 2 hdc, 1 hdc in next 3 hdc, 2 hdc in next 5 hdc, 1 hdc in next 3 hdc, 2 hdc in next 3

hdc. Join in first hdc of this round (26 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### **Teddy Bear Nose:**

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With dark brown yarn do 4 ch.

1 round: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next ch, 3 sc in next ch, working now in the opposite side of the

foundation ch, 1 sc in next ch, 2 sc in next ch (8 sts).

2 round: 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc. Join with sl st in

first sc of this round (14 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

#### **Teddy Bear Ear: (x2)**

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With light brown yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc \* repeat 5 more times (18 sts).

**3 to 5 round:** 1 sc in each sc (18 sts, 3 rounds in total).

6 round: \* 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog \* repeat 5 more times (12 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing

that piece later.

 $\cdot$  Sew the edges of each ear following the instructions on page 3, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".



Crochet Pattern

#### **Finishing the Teddy Bear Cocoon:**

- · With beige yarn sew the snout on the teddy bear base. Place it next to the outer edge, between rounds 4 and 7.
- · With dark brown yarn sew the nose. Place it on foundation ch of the snout and round 3 of the teddy bear base. Then make a long stitch down, 1 st length. Fasten off.
- · To make the eyes sew 2 black buttons on the teddy bear base. Place them centered with the snout, in round 2. For your reference the eyes have a distance of 1 st between them.
- · Sew the ears on the teddy bear base. Place them centered with the face, between rounds 3 and 6.



· Place the base on the edge of the cocoon, folded in half, leaving the face on the outer side. Then sew the edge of the base to the cocoon. Remember you must also sew the edge of the base to the inside of the bag. Fasten off.




