### Materials:

Yarn:

Yarn in 7 colors: For the doll in the photo I used thin 4ply sock yarn.

Hook:

2.5 mm

Others:

Fiberfill, yarn needle

Measurements:

The finished doll will measure approximately 21 cm if you use the same kind of yarn and hook

that I've used.

Colors:

A: skin color E: mouth, stripes B: hair, nose F: hat, braces,

B: hair, nose F: hat, braces, and socks and shoes C: bow G: pants

D: blue stripes

Fasten off. Roll up the edge of the hat.



## Bow

Color C.

Start with a chain of 20 and close the round with a slst into the first ch. Crochet 2 rounds 1hdc in each stitch, start every round with 2ch (2ch will count as the first hdc). Close every round with a slst into the 2nd ch. Wrap the yarn several times around the middle to make a bow. Knot the yarn ends, fasten off securely. Leave a tail for sewing.



#### Legs (make 2): Flatten the leg and close the opening with a series rnd of sc. Fasten off, leave Start with Color F. a tail for sewing. 6sc in MR 2 [inc] 6x 12 3 12 4-9 inc, 5sc, dec, 4sc 12 (6 rnds) 10-11 dec, 5sc, inc, 4sc 12 (2 rnds) Stuff the foot, don't stuff the rest of the lea. Change to color B. The funny sequence of stitches for the legs [dec, sc] 4x 8 make cute feet. sc (6 rnds) 8 13-19



## Hair (make 2)

For each hair piece you will crochet 6 curls. You will crochet them without cutting the yarn.

Start with a chain of 13 and crochet back down the chain. Start in the 2nd ch from hook (do this for all curls) [sc, inc]6x and add a slst into the last ch.

2. 11ch and [sc, inc]5x back down the chain. Make 1sc in the base of the previous curl. 3. 9ch and [sc, inc]4x back down the chain. Make 1sc in the base of the previous curl. 4. 13ch and [sc, inc]6x back down the chain. Make 1sc in the base of the previous curl. 5. 11ch and [sc.inc]5x back down the chain. Make 1sc in the base of the previous curl. 6. 9ch and [sc, inc]4x back down the chain. Make 1sc in the base of the previous curl. Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing.

## Pants

Color G.

1rst pants leg:

Fasten	off.		

Repeat R1-5 to make the 2nd pants leg but do not cut the yarn at the end. Now you will join the two pieces:

6: 1 ch, insert your hook into any stitch of the last round of the first pants leg and crochet 1 sc in each stitch around =24 sts, 1 sc into the ch which joins the two pieces, 24 sc around the first piece and 1 sc into the ch (50)

7-19 sc (13 rnds) 50
20 slst 50
Fasten off. Roll the bottom edge of the pants up.
For the braces crochet 2 chains long enough to cross at the back (see photo). I needed 45ch. Crochet slst back down the chain. Sew the braces onto the pants with an upside down "V" (see photo). Fasten off.





### Mouth

Crochet a chain of 17ch. Start in the 2nd chain from hook and crochet around the whole chain.

1 15sc, 3inc, 14sc, inc 34 2 inc, [dec] 7x, inc slst (this round will not be finished) Fasten off and leave a tail for sewing

# Finishing:

Sew the nose onto the face. It should line up with the mouth, see photo.

Sew the bow onto the body.

Embroider black eyes in the length of 3 stitches 2-3 times in a vertical line. Make sure you use the same 2 holes (a distance of 13 stitches between the eyes). The embroidered eyes should overlap a little bit on the mouth.

Sew the mouth onto the face. It should line up with the edging between head and body.

Sew the hair pieces onto the head.

Stuff the body and sew the head onto the body.

Sew the arms onto the sides. Sew them with a distance of 1 round to the edging between head and body.

Sew the legs onto the body. The foot peaks should point at each other and the heels should point to the side; a distance of 3 rnds from the middle of the body. Sew the legs a little further to the front.
