

YOU WILL NEED FOLLOWING MATERIALS & SUPPLIES:

1. Yarn for body Alize Cotton Gold (50% cotton/50% acrylic) 100 g/330 m (3,5 oz/361 yd) color №161 pink (1/2 skein), №55 white and №60 black;
2. Hook size 2mm (metal US,UK 1);
3. Fiber filling;
4. Black thread for embroidering eyes;
5. Any yarn of yellow color for crochet hat and pompon;
6. Tapestry needle for sewing details, scissors;
7. Piece of fabric for sarafan/dress.

*Size of the toy is about 25 cm/9,8 in

ABBREVIATIONS :

MR - magic ring

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Dc - double crochet

Tr - treble crochet

Dtr - double treble crochet

St - stitch

Inc - increase (2 sc or 2 dc in one st)

Dec - invisible decrease (crochet next 2 st together)

BLO - back loops only

[n] Inc/Dec - increase/decrease [n] times in a row

Sl st - slip stitch

R - row/round

() x... - repeat instructions in brackets ... times

Number in () at the end of the Row indicates number of st in that Row



So, my dear friend, are you ready to start our small adventure?

I promise that the process won't be boring at all, on the contrary it will wake up your imagination and make you achieve a desirable result. It is a kind of a quest when you finish it you will be surprised and willing to do it again and again! :) Well, my little friend, get all the necessary materials, which you should have already prepared out of the bins, take your place on your lovely sofa and don't forget to make a cup of aroma coffee or tea and let's begin.



HEAD :

Work with main color yarn **Pink**.

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: 6 inc (12)

R3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

R4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

R5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

R6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)



R7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

R8: (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

R9: (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)

R10-18 (9 rounds): 54 sc

R19: (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)

R20: (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)

R21: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

R22: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

R23: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)



R24: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

Cut the yarn.

Stuff tight.

Hide yarn tail inside the detail.



BEAK :

Start working with **Black** color yarn.

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: (1 sc, inc) x 3 (9)

R3: 9 sc

R4: (2 sc, inc) x 3 (12)

R5: 12 sc

Crochet curve in turns:

- 3 sc, sl st into the 4th st, turn;
- 4 sc, sl st into the 5th st, turn;
- 5 sc, sl st into the 6th st, turn;
- 6 sc, sl st into the 7th st, turn;

Continue to crochet around on the right side.

R6: 12 sc

Change yarn color to **White**.

R7: (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15)

R8: 15 sc

R9: (4 sc, inc) x 3 (18)

R10: 18 sc

Stuff tight. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for assembly.



WINGS :

Crochet for one wing:

Start working with **Black** color yarn.

Crochet 3 details:

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2: 6 inc (12)

R3-6: 12 sc

When you will be crocheting 3rd detail, don't cut the yarn and start to join details together.

R7: crochet 6 sc on the 1st detail, join second one, crochet 6 sc on the 2nd detail, join third one, crochet all remaining stitches with sc. In the end you should end up with $12+12+12=36$ sc

Change yarn color to **White**.

R8-9: 36 sc

Change yarn color to **Pink**.

R10: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

R11: 30 sc

R12: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

R13: 24 sc

R14: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

R15: 18 sc

R16: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

R17-36 (20 rounds): 12 sc

Don't stuff the wings.

Fold edges together and sc them.

Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

Crochet second wing the same way.





LEGS + BODY:

For one leg:

Start to crochet paw with **Black** color yarn. Crochet 3 details:

R1: 6 sc in MR

R2-5: 6 sc

When you crochet third detail don't cut the yarn and start to join details together.

R6: crochet 3 sc on the 1st detail, join second one, crochet 3 sc on the 2nd detail, join third one and crochet all remaining stitches with sc. In the end we should end up with $6+6+6=18$ sc

R7-8: 18 sc

R9: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

R10: 12 sc

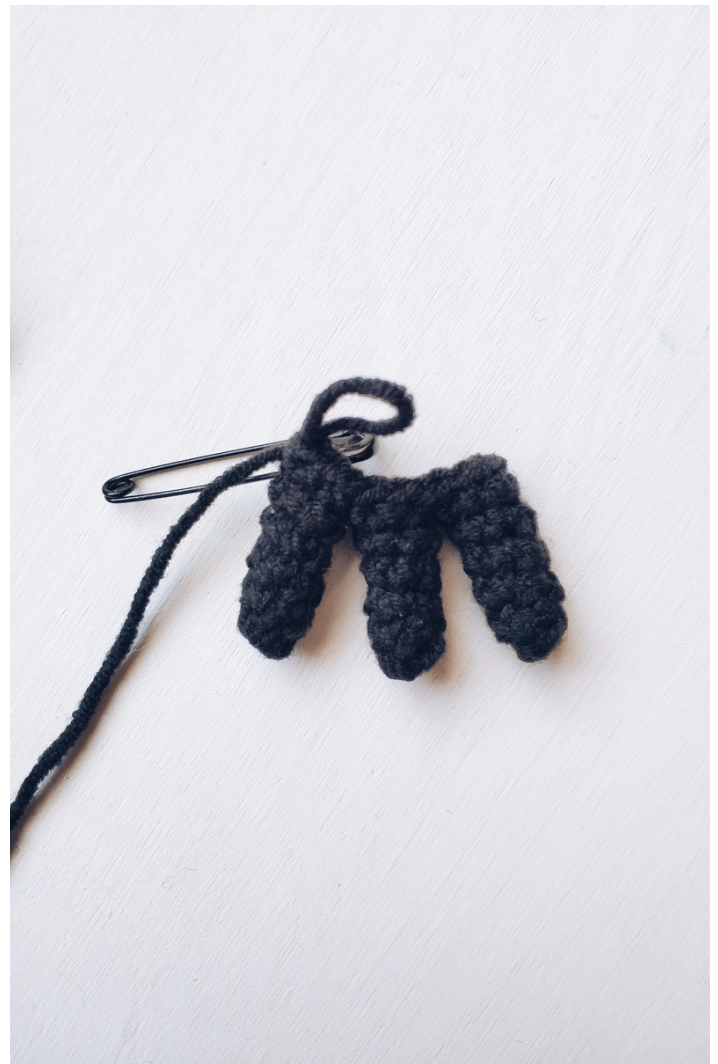
Stuff with fiber.

Change yarn color to **Pink**.

R11-40: 12 sc

Cut the yarn. Stuff.

Crochet second leg the same way only don't cut the yarn in the end. We will be joining legs next.





R41: 1 sc, ch 12, join first leg and place a marker. That will be first st of the row. Then crochet 12 sc on the first leg, 12 sc on the chain, 12 sc on the second leg and 12 sc on the other side of the chain.

We should end up with 48 sc.

R42-58 (17 rounds): 48 sc

R59: (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)

R60-61: 42 sc

R62: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

R63-64: 36 sc

R65: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

R66-67: 30 sc

R68: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

R69-70: 24 sc

R71: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

R72-77: 18 sc



Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.

Stuff the body tight.

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ASSEMBLY :

Sew head to the body previously securing it with pins around. When we have small hole left, stuff the area between head and body tight enough, so our head don't hang out. Then sew details to the end. Hide yarn tail inside the detail.



Sew wings symmetrically on the sides of the body, previously securing them with pins.



Next sew beak to the head placing it in the middle of the head.



Embroider eyes with black embroidery floss (3 threads).

results! I'm sure they

SARAFAN/DRESS :

Cut piece of fabric for skirt size 12x38 cm/ 4,72x15 in. If there are a lot of loose threads coming off of your cut edge, bend and stitch it. Bend top of the fabric about 1,5 cm/0,6 in from the edge. Iron it. Take elastic the length that is equal to the waist circumference of the toy. I've got 18 cm. Then with the help of sewing machine, sew elastic to the top of the fabric while stretching it along the entire length of the fabric. As a result, the fabric should be pulled into the skirt. Then make two parallel stitches on the elastic for more beautiful folds.





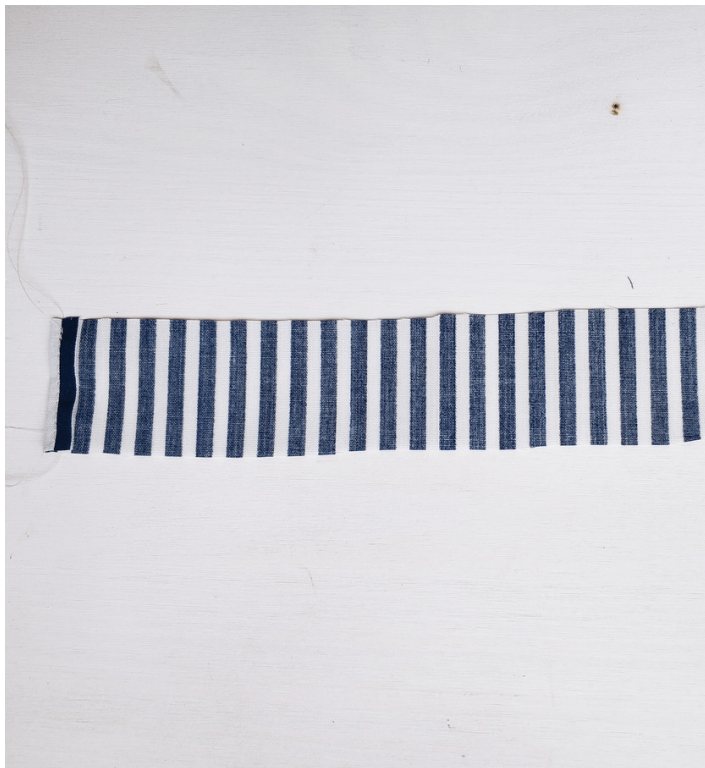
Then fold the skirt in half and sew edges together. Our skirt is ready.



Next, cut 4 strips for straps size 3x20 cm/1,18x7,87 in.

Fold top and bottom as shown on the picture. Then sew sides from the wrong side. Turn the straps out.

Sew the straps to the skirt. 2 on the front and 2 on the back of the skirt. You can decorate sarafan with buttons on the front.





HAT :

Take any yellow yarn for the hat. Just make sure you are using suitable hook size.

Crochet:

R1: 6 sc in MR, sl st in the end of the row

R2: ch 1, 6 inc, sl st (12)

R3: ch 1, (1 sc, inc) x 6, sl st (18)

R4: ch 1, (2 sc, inc) x 6, sl st (24)

R5: ch 1, BLO 24 sc, sl st (24)

R6-8: ch 1, 24 sc, sl st (24)

R9: ch 3, 24 dc inc, sl st (48)

R10: ch 3, (6 dc, inc) x 6, sl st (54)

R11: ch 1, 54 sc, sl st (54)



Decorate the hat with pompons and make the strings.
