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## SIZE

	S	M	L	
To fit age	10-11	12-13	14-16	years

## YARN

### Rowan Cocoon

	6	7	7	x 100gm
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(photographed in Bilberry 812)

## NEEDLES

1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles  
1 pair 7mm (no 2) (US 10½) needles  
Cable needle

## TENSION

14 sts and 16 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 7mm (US 10½) needles.

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**C6B** = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle; **C6F** = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle.

## BACK

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 65 [67: 71] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P1, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 4 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 7mm (US 10½) needles.\*\*

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Next row (RS):** K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Working all decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at each end of 8th and foll 8th row. 59 [61: 65] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 27 [28: 29] cm, ending with RS facing

for next row.

## Shape armholes

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 53 [55: 59] sts.

**Next row (RS):** K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

**Next row:** P1, P2tog, P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, P1.

Working all decreases as set by last 2 rows, dec 1 st at each end of next 1 [1: 3] rows, then on foll alt row. 45 [47: 47] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 19 [20: 21] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Shape back neck and shoulders

**Next row (RS):** Cast off 6 sts, K until there are 9 [10: 9] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 6 [7: 6] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 15 [15: 17] sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

## POCKET BACK

Using 7mm (US 10½) needles cast on 29 sts.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 6 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

## FRONT

Work as given for back to \*\*.

Beg with a K row, work in st st for 6 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

## Place pocket

**Next row (RS):** K18 [19: 21], slip next 29 sts onto a holder and, in their place, K across 29 sts of pocket back, K to end. 65 [67: 71] sts.

Working decreases as set by back, dec 1 st at each end of 2nd and foll 8th row. 61 [63: 67] sts.

Work 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave these sts on a 2nd holder.

### Shape pocket front

Rejoin yarn to 29 sts left on first holder with RS facing and cont as folls:

Working decreases as set by back, dec 1 st at each end of next and foll 2 alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 19 sts.

Work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn.

### Join sections

**Next row (RS):** K first 21 [22: 24] sts left on 2nd holder, holding WS of pocket front against RS of pocket back, K tog first st of pocket front with next st on 2nd holder, (K tog next st of pocket front with next st on 2nd holder) 18 times, K rem 21 [22: 24] sts on 2nd holder. 61 [63: 67] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next row. 59 [61: 65] sts.

Cont straight until 9 rows less have been worked than on back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

**Next row (WS):** P25 [26: 28], M1P, (P2, M1P) 4 times, P to end. 64 [66: 70] sts.

Now work in cable patt as folls:

**Row 1 (RS):** K23 [24: 26], (C6F) 3 times, K to end.

**Row 2 and every foll alt row:** Purl.

**Row 3:** Knit.

**Row 5:** K26 [27: 29], (C6B) twice, K to end.

**Row 7:** Knit.

**Row 8:** Purl.

These 8 rows form cable patt.

### Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 58 [60: 64] sts. Working all decreases as set by back armholes, dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [3: 5] rows, then on foll alt row. 50 [52: 52] sts.

Cont straight until 8 [10: 12] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape neck

**Next row (RS):** K17 [19: 19] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder. Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows, then on foll 1 [2: 3] alt rows. 12 [13: 12] sts.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 6 [7: 6] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 16 [14: 14] sts dec 4 sts evenly across these sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

### SLEEVES

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 30 [30: 34] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K2, \*P2, K2, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P2, \*K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and 2 foll 6th rows, taking inc sts into rib. 36 [36: 40] sts.

Work 1 row, dec [inc: dec] 1 st at centre of row and ending with RS facing for next row. 35 [37: 39] sts.

Change to 7mm (US 10 1/2) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 6th row to 41 [43: 43] sts, then on every foll 8th row until there are 47 [49: 51] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 42 [43: 44] cm, ending with RS facing

for next row.

### Shape top

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 41 [43: 45] sts.

Working all decreases as set by back armholes, dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row until 27 sts rem, then on foll 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 17 sts.

### MAKING UP

Press.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

### Hood

Using 6mm (US 10) needles cast on 111 sts.

Work in rib as given for back for 6 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 7mm (US 10 1/2) needles.

Beg with a K row, work in st st, dec 1 st at each end of next and foll 4 alt rows. 101 sts.

Cont straight until hood meas 16 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Shape back

Place marker on centre st of last row.

**Row 1 (RS):** K to within 2 sts of marked st, K2tog, K marked st, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to end. 99 sts.

Work 3 rows.

**Row 5:** As row 1. 97 sts.

Work 1 row.

**Row 7:** K to within 2 sts of marked st, K2tog, K marked st, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to end. 95 sts.

**Row 8:** P to within 2 sts of marked st, P2tog tbl, P marked st, P2tog, P to end. 93 sts.

Rep last 2 rows twice more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 85 sts.

Fold hood in half and join cast-off edges to form back seam. Positioning ends of cast-on edge so that they meet at centre front neck and hood seam at centre back neck, sew shaped row-end edges of hood to neck edge, easing in fullness.

### Pocket borders (both alike)

With RS facing and using 6mm (US 10) needles, pick up and knit 17 sts evenly along shaped row-end edge of pocket opening.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 2 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Cast off in rib (on **WS**).

Set in sleeves using the set-in method.
