# 1. Instruments and materials

- 0.85 and 1.00 mm hook
- Black, white, navy blue, dark brown, marsh green, light brown, brown, crimson, milky white and terracotta yarn. Also mouline DMC 310, DMC 761, DMC 712, DMC 642
- Sewing needle
- A piece of wire
- Stuffing material



**Zombie** - character of the popular game “Plants vs. Zombies”, that was developed and released by PopCap Games.

This toy was crocheted with “Iris” yarn. This is 100% cotton, 150m/25g. To create a toy with a height of 15.5 cm you must crochet with single yarn using a 1.00 mm hook. To crochet teeth you should use mouline DMC 712 (in three threads) and 0.85 mm hook. The stuffing material used in this toy is polyester wadding.

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## 2. Abbreviations

<b>Ch</b>	chain
<b>Sc</b>	single crochet
<b>Dc</b>	double crochet
<b>Tr</b>	treble crochet
<b>HDc</b>	half double crochet
<b>Sl</b>	slip stitch
<b>INC</b>	increase
<b>INVDEC</b>	invisible decrease
<b>Tr INVDEC</b>	treble invisible decrease
<b>BLO</b>	back loops only
<b>FLO</b>	front loops only

### Tip 2

**To keep track of the beginning of the row, use a marker. Pin marker to the last loop of the row. Every new row must be finished with a loop at the marker.**

### Tip 1

**The toy must be crocheted with tight stitches, to be sure that there won't be any holes through which stuffing material can be seen.**

All amigurumi toys are crocheted with tight stitches. Avoid small holes when stretching crochet fabric, if there are some tiny holes, use a smaller size hook. To avoid seams, all details are crocheted in a spiral without slip stitch and lifting loops. There is a chance that you will lose the beginning of the row; to avoid this, use a marker. It can be a colored pin or thread of contrasting color.

# 3. Boots

Right boot

**With brown yarn**

Ch7

- 1 row** Sc in second stitch, 4Sc, 3Sc in the next stitch (crochet round), 4Sc, 2Sc in the next stitch (that already has the very first single crochet) (14)
- 2 row** INC, 4Sc, 3INC, 4Sc, 2INC (20)
- 3 row** Sc in each Sc around (20)
- 4 row** 10Sc, INC, (2Sc, INC) repeat 3 times (24)
- 5 row** Sc in each Sc around (24)
- 6 row** 14Sc, INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc (22)
- 7 row** Sc in each Sc around (22)
- 8 row** 14Sc, 2INVDEC, 4Sc (20)
- 9 row** 12Sc, BLO7Sc, 1Sc (20)
- 10 row** Sc in each Sc around (20)  
For the 11th row, the 7 stitches marked by a star must be crocheted on the front loops only of those 7 stitches on the 9th row of which you had crocheted the back loops only.
- 11 row** 12Sc, \*7Sc, 1Sc (20)

## 3.1 Boots

- 12 — 13 rows Sc in each Sc around (20)  
14 row 10Sc, Ch turn (10)  
15 — 19 rows 8Sc, Ch turn (8)  
20 row INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (6)  
21 row INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (4)  
22 row Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 4Sc, 6Sc (into transverse loops), INVDEC, 8Sc, INVDEC, 7Sc (into transverse loops) (27)  
23 row 9Sc, 2INVDEC, 4Sc, 2INVDEC, 6Sc (23)  
24 row FLO9Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, 6Sc (21), Sl

Cut the yarn.

### Tip 3

**Crochet the second stitch (skip the first stitch) from the hook after the turn, if it is not mentioned to do it in another way.**

## 3.2 Boots

Left boot

**With brown yarn**

Ch7

- 1 row** Sc in second stitch, 4Sc, 3Sc in the next stitch (crochet round), 4Sc, 2Sc in the next stitch (that already has the very first single crochet) (14)
  - 2 row** INC, 4Sc, 3INC, 4Sc, 2INC (20)
  - 3 row** Sc in each Sc around (20)
  - 4 row** INC, (2Sc, INC) repeat 3 times, 10Sc (24)
  - 5 row** Sc in each Sc around (24)
  - 6 row** 4Sc, INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC, 14Sc (22)
  - 7 row** Sc in each Sc around (22)
  - 8 row** 4Sc, 2INVDEC, 14Sc (20)
  - 9 row** 2Sc, BLO7Sc, 11Sc (20)
  - 10 row** Sc in each Sc around (20)
- For the 11th row, the 7 stitches marked by a star must be crocheted on the front loops only of those 7 stitches on the 9th row of which you had crocheted the back loops only.
- 11 row** 2Sc, \*7Sc, 11Sc (20)

## 3.3 Boots

- 12 row Sc in each Sc around (20)
- 13 row 20Sc, Ch turn (20)
- 14 – 19 rows 8Sc, Ch turn (8)
- 20 row INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (6)
- 21 row INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC (4)
- 22 row Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 7Sc (into transverse loops), INVDEC, 8Sc, INVDEC, 6Sc (into transverse loops), 4Sc (27)
- 23 row 6Sc, 2INVDEC, 4Sc, 2INVDEC, 9Sc (23)
- 24 row FLO6Sc, FLOINVDEC, FLO4Sc, FLOINVDEC, FLO9Sc (21), SI

Cut the yarn.

## 4. Heel

**With dark brown yarn**

Ch6

- 1 row Sc in second stitch, 4Sc, Ch turn (5)
- 2 – 3 rows 5Sc, Ch turn (5)
- 4 row INVDEC, 1Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (3)
- 5 row Tr INVDEC (1)
- 6 row Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 1Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 3Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 1Sc, INC (19), SI
- 7 row BLO19Sc (19)

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

# 5. Sole

## **With terracotta yarn**

Ch8

**1 row** Sc in second stitch, 6Sc, Ch turn (7)

**2 row** INC, 5Sc, INC, Ch turn (9)

**3 – 4 rows** 9Sc, Ch turn (9)

**5 row** 9Sc (9)

**6 row** Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 1Sc (in the same stitch), 13Sc, INC (16)

Connect dark brown yarn and cut terracotta one.

**7 row** 9Sc, Ch turn (9)

**8 row** INVDEC, 5Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (7)

**9 row** 7Sc (7)

## 5.1 Sole

- 10 row** Crochet the whole circumference of the detail:  
1Sc, INVDEC, FLO1Sc, FLO12HDc, FLO1Sc,  
INVDEC, 1Sc (25)
- 11 – 12 rows** 7Sc, Ch turn (7)
- 13 row** INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc (in the same stitch, e.g.  
in INVDEC), 2Sc (into transverse loops) (8), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Make 2 details.

## 6. Boots assembly

Put the sole under the toecap as shown on the photos. Sew it with the end of brown yarn that we left before. Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the boot. Stuff the heel with stuffing material and place it at the back bottom part of the boot. Sew it with the end of dark brown yarn that we left before. Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the heel. Bend the toecap a little. Repeat with the second boot.

# 7. Legs

**With marsh green yarn**

Connect marsh green yarn to the first loop of the 24th row of the boot, where you crocheted front loops only. 24th row of the boot has 21Sc, and the first row of the leg should be 10Sc, so you must crochet:

**1 row** 5INVDEC, skip 1 stitch of the 24th row of the boot, 5INVDEC (10)

**2 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times, 1Sc (7)

Take some soft wire and bend it, making it look like a foot. At this phase you must insert the wire into the boot and only after this you should continue crocheting the leg. If you try to insert it after having crocheted the leg, you will find out that it is difficult because the leg is very thin.

**3 – 4 rows** Sc in each Sc around (7)

**5 row** INC, 6Sc (8)

**6 – 7 rows** Sc in each Sc around (8)

**8 row** INC, 7Sc (9)

**9 – 10 rows** Sc in each Sc around (9)

**11 row** INC, 8Sc (10)

**12 row** Sc in each Sc around (10)

Starting from the 13th row, the patterns for crocheting the left and the right legs are different.

# 7.1 Legs

Right leg

- 13 row 10Sc, 1Sc (extra stitch made to help conceal the unshapely edges) (10)
- 14 row 3Sc, INVDEC, 3Sc, 2INCDc (11)  
INVDEC in the 14th row should be positioned directly at the back center of the leg. (Image 37)
- 15 row 2Sc, 4Sl, 1Sc, 2INVDECDc (9)
- 16 row 2Sc, FLO4Sc, 3Sc (9)
- 17 row 3Sc, INC, 5Sc (10)
- 18 – 19 rows Sc in each Sc around (10)
- 20 row INC, 9Sc (11)
- 21 – 22 rows Sc in each Sc around (11)
- 23 row 1Sc, INC, 9Sc (12)
- 24 – 25 rows Sc in each Sc around (12)
- 26 row 2Sc, INC, 9Sc (13)
- 27 – 28 rows Sc in each Sc around (13)
- 29 row 12INC, 1Sc (25), Sl

Cut the yarn.

## Tip 4

**Add one or few more extra stitches to the 13th row if you see that your INVDEC in the 14th row will not be positioned directly at the back center of the leg.**

## 7.2 Legs

Left leg

- 13 row 9Sc, (1 stitch should be left uncrocheted) (10)
- 14 row 2INCDc, 2Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc(11)  
INVDEC in the 14th row should be positioned directly at the back center of the leg. (Image 37)
- 15 row 2INVDECDc, 1Sc, 4Sl, 2Sc (9)
- 16 row 3Sc, FLO4Sc, 2Sc (9)
- 17 row 4Sc, INC, 4Sc (10)
- 18 – 19 rows Sc in each Sc around (10)
- 20 row INC, 9Sc (11)
- 21 – 22 rows Sc in each Sc around (11)
- 23 row 3Sc, INC, 7Sc (12)
- 24 – 25 rows Sc in each Sc around (12)
- 26 row 5Sc, INC, 6Sc (13)
- 27 – 28 rows Sc in each Sc around (13)
- 29 row 12INC, 1Sc (25), Sl

Cut the yarn.

Bend the knees a little.

## Tip 5

**Add one or few more uncrocheted stitches to 13th row if you see that your INVDEC on the 14th row will not be positioned directly at the back center of the**

## 7.3 Legs

Hide the end of yarn, with which you crocheted the boot, inside the detail.

Connect light brown yarn and embroider the shoelace on the boots.

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the ends inside the boots.

**With navy blue yarn**

Ch30, connect in ring

1 – 6 rows Sc in each Sc around (30)

7 row INVDEC, 28Sc (29)

8 row INVDEC, 27Sc (28)

9 row INVDEC, 26Sc (27)

10 row 1Sc, 6Ch (*Image 50*),

Sc in second stitch, 4Sc, connect to the base 1Sc (*Image 51*), Ch turn,

Sc in third stitch (*Image 52*), 3Sc, Ch turn (*Image 53*),

Sc in third stitch (*Image 54*),

# 8.1 Pants

Left trouser-leg (bottom)

continue:

- 10 row** 2Sc (*Image 55*), connect to the base, skipping 1 stitch in the base 1Sc (*Images 56 and 57*), Ch turn, Sc in third stitch, 1Sc, Ch turn (*Image 58*), Sc in third stitch (*Image 59*), connect to the base, skipping 1 stitch in the base 1Sc (*Image 60*), 4Ch (*Image 61*), Sc in second stitch, 2Sc, connect to the base 1Sc (*Image 62*)

## 8.2 Pants

Left trouser-leg (bottom)

- 10 row** continue:  
continue crocheting to the end  
of the row 19Sc, Sl

Cut the yarn, hiding all ends on the back side of the detail. Give a shape to the trouser-leg folding it a little. (Image 64) Two states of the trouser-leg are shown on the Image 64: unfolded on the left and folded on the right.

## 8.3 Pants

Left trouser-leg (top)

**With navy blue yarn**

Ch25, connect in ring

- 1 – 6 rows** Sc in each Sc around (25)  
**7 row** 25Sc, Ch turn (25)  
**8 row** 6Sc, Ch turn (6)

Cut the yarn, leave a small end of the yarn for connecting the trouser-legs.

Connect navy blue yarn to the first stitch of the first row of this trouser-leg and crochet:

## 8.4 Pants

Left trouser-leg (top)

- 9 row** 6Sc, Sl, 2Ch, 2HDc, 1Dc, 3Ch, Sl (in the same stitch as Dc), 2Sl, 2Ch, 2Dc, 2Tr, 3Ch, Sl (in the same stitch as Tr), 2Sl, 3Ch, 1Dc, 2HDc, 2Ch, Sl (in the same stitch as HDc), 4Sc (25), Sl  
Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end on the back side of the detail.

## 8.5 Pants

Right trouser-leg

**With navy blue yarn**

Ch30, connect in ring

- 1 – 6 rows** Sc in each Sc around (30)  
**7 row** INVDEC, 28Sc (29)  
**8 row** INVDEC, 27Sc (28)  
**9 row** INVDEC, 26Sc (27)  
**10 – 18 rows** Sc in each Sc around (27)  
**19 row** INVDEC, 16Sc, 9Sl (26)  
**20 row** 17Sc, FLO9Sc (26)  
**21 – 26 rows** Sc in each Sc around (26)  
**27 row** 1Sc, INVDEC, 23Sc (25)  
**28 – 34 rows** Sc in each Sc around (25)

Do not cut the yarn.

Hide all ends of yarn on the back side of the detail. Give a shape to the trouser-leg folding it a little on the bottom. Two states of the trouser-leg are shown on the Images 69 and 70: unfolded on the right and folded on the left.

## 8.6 Pants

Connection of the trouser-legs are made with the end of the yarn that we left before on the left trouser-leg.

Skip 8 stitches from the last stitch on the right trouser-leg and start connection to the 9th stitch.

Insert the hook to the front loop of the stitch on the right trouser-leg and then insert to the back loop of the stitch on the left trouser-leg and crochet Sc. Crochet 5 more Sc in the same way.

Cut the yarn.

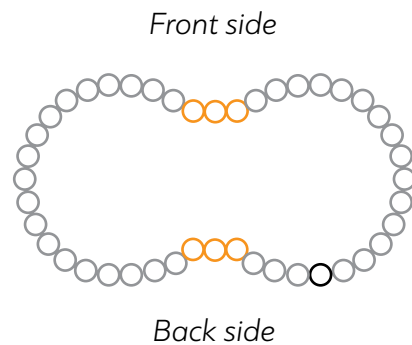

# 9. Body

Put the left trouser-leg (bottom) on the left leg. Then insert the right leg into the right trouser-leg and the left leg into left trouser-leg (top). Place the legs so that the knees are facing each other and fasten the legs with some pins. Crochet with the yarn on the right leg, taking both loops of the stitches of the trouser-legs (navy blue) and back loops only of the legs (marsh green).

**1 row** 3Sc (on the right trouser-leg), 3Sc (into transverse loops), 19Sc (on the left trouser-leg), 3Sc (into transverse loops), 16Sc (on the right trouser-leg) (44)

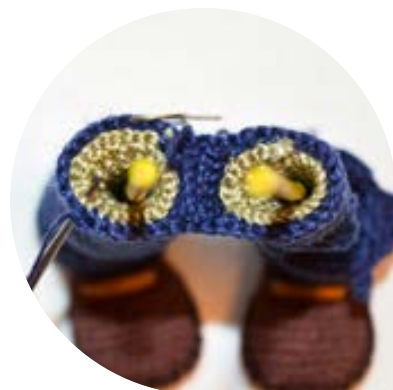

Cut the extra wire.

- 2 row INC, 7Sc, INC, 35Sc (46)
- 3 – 4 rows Sc in each Sc around (46)
- 5 row INVDEC, 7Sc, INVDEC, 35Sc (44)
- 6 row Sc in each Sc around (44)
- Connect white yarn and cut navy blue one.
- 7 row FLOSc in each Sc around (44)
- 8 – 21 rows Sc in each Sc around (44)
- 22 row 14Sc, 2INVDEC, 18Sc, 2INVDEC, 4Sc (40)
- 23 row 13Sc, 2INVDEC, 16Sc, 2INVDEC, 3Sc (36)
- 24 row 12Sc, 2INVDEC, 14Sc, 2INVDEC, 2Sc (32)
- Stuff detail with stuffing material, continue crocheting.
- 25 row INVDEC, 6Sc, 5INVDEC, 6Sc, 4INVDEC (22)
- 26 row 3Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC (18)

## 9.2 Body

Connect marsh green yarn and cut white one.

- 27 row** BLOSc in each Sc around (18)
- 28 row** 9Sc, Ch turn (9)
- 29 row** Sc in third stitch, 7Sc, Ch turn (8)
- 30 row** Sc in third stitch, 6Sc, 1Sc (into transverse loop), 9Sc, 1Sc (into transverse loop) (18), Sl

## 10. Collar

Connect white yarn to the 14th Sc of the 27th row, where you crocheted back loops only.

- 1 row** 19Sc (e.g. 18Sc, 1Sc in the first of 18Sc), Ch turn (19)
- 2 row** 2Sc, (INC, 1Sc) repeat 7 times, INC, 2Sc, 2Ch turn (27)
- 3 row** 2Dc, 1HDc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 3Sc, INC, 3Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 1HDc, 2Dc (34)  
Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end on the back side of the collar.

- 3 row** 1Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 9Sc (18)
- 4 row** 2Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 6Sc, INC (22)
- 5 row** 3Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 3Sc, INC, 7Sc, INC (26)
- 6 row** 4Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 8Sc, INC (30)
- 7 row** 4Sc, INC, 7Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 9Sc, INC, 1Sc (34)
- 8 row** 4Sc, INC, 9Sc, INC, 7Sc, INC, 8Sc, INC, 2Sc (38)
- 9 row** 6Sc, INC, 9Sc, INC, 8Sc, INC, 9Sc, INC, 2Sc (42)
- 10 row** 6Sc, FLO(INC, 1Sc) repeat 5 times, FLOINC, 25Sc (48)

Connect marsh green yarn and cut black one.

- 11 row** 6Sc, FLO17Sc, 25Sc (48)
- 12 row** (7Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (54), Sl

Cut the yarn.

- 3 row** 1Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 9Sc (18)
- 4 row** 2Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 2Sc, INC, 6Sc, INC (22)
- 5 row** 3Sc, INC, 4Sc, INC, 5Sc, Ch turn (16)
- 6 row** 5Sc, INC, 5Sc, INC, 4Sc, Ch turn (18)
- 7 row** 17Sc, INC, Ch turn (19)
- 8 row** INC, 17Sc, INC, Ch turn (21)
- 9 row** INC, 4Sc, INC, 7Sc, INC, 7Sc, 16Ch (40)

**13 row** 4Sc, INC, 32Sc, INC, 20Sc (60)

**14 row** 15Sc, INC, 12Sc, INC, 31Sc (62)

**15 – 16 rows** Sc in each Sc around (62)

**17 row** 4Sc, INVDEC, 9Sc, INVDEC, 12Sc, INVDEC, 9Sc, INVDEC, 20Sc (58)

**18 row** 7Sc, INVDEC, 7Sc, INVDEC, 6Sc, INVDEC, 7Sc, INVDEC, 23Sc (54)

# 11.3 Head

Insert the inner detail and stuff the head with stuffing material, continue crocheting.

- 19 row Sc in each Sc around (54)
- 20 row (7Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (48)
- 21 row Sc in each Sc around (48)
- 22 row (6Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (42)
- 23 row (5Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (36)
- 24 row (4Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (30)
- 25 row (3Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (24)
- 26 row (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 27 row (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (12)
- 28 row 6INVDEC (12), SI

Cut the yarn. Tighten all stitches and hide the end inside the head.

  - 2 – 4 rows** Sc in each Sc around (6)
  - 5 row** 3Sc (3), Sl
- Cut the yarn.  
Make 2 details.

The first row is crocheted in the same way for the left and right hands.

**With marsh green yarn**

- 1 row** forefinger: 1Sc,  
middle finger: 2Sc,  
ring finger: 2Sc,  
little finger: 3Sc (1 stitch should be left uncrocheted),  
ring finger: 2Sc (1 stitch should be left uncrocheted),  
middle finger: 2Sc (1 stitch should be left uncrocheted),  
forefinger: 4Sc (16)

The patterns for the left and right arms are different starting from the second row.

- 4 row** 13Sc,

- 6 – 14 rows** 48Sc, Ch turn (48)
- 15 row** INVDEC, 44Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (46)
- 16 row** 11Sc, INC, 22Sc, INC, 11Sc, Ch turn (48)
- 17 row** INVDEC, 44Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (46)
- 18 row** 44Sc, Ch turn (44)
- 19 row** INVDEC, 8Sc, (INVDEC, 6Sc) repeat 3 times, INVDEC, 8Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (40)
- 20 row** 40Sc, Ch turn (40)
- 21 row** INVDEC, 5Sc, 2INVDEC, 5Sc, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC, 5Sc, 2INVDEC, 5Sc, INVDEC, Ch turn (32)
- 22 row** 32Sc, Ch turn (32)
- 23 row** INVDEC, 4Sc, (INVDEC, 1Sc) repeat 6 times, INVDEC, 4Sc, INVDEC (23)
- 24 row** Crochet the whole circumference of the detail: 1Sc (in the same stitch), 21Sc (into transverse loops), 1Sc (corner), 3Ch, 1Dc (in the same stitch - corner), 3Dc, 2Ch, 2Sl, 2Ch, 1Dc, 1Ch, 1Sc, 1Ch, 3Dc, 2Ch, 2Sl, 22Sc, 2Sl, 2Ch, 3Dc, 1Ch, 1Sc, 1Ch, 1Dc, 2Ch, 2Sl, 2Ch, 3Dc, 1Dc (corner), 2Ch, 1Sc (corner), 22Sc (into transverse loops), 23Sc (117), Sl

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end on the back side of the jacket.

Starting from the 11th row, the patterns for crocheting the left and right sleeves are different.

Left sleeve

**11 row** 1Sc, 7Sl, 5Sc, Ch turn (13)

**12 row** 5Sc, 7Sc (using stitches of the 10th row) (Image 140), 1Sc, Ch turn (13)

**13 row** 13Sc, Ch turn (13)

**14 row** 13Sc, 4Ch (17)

Connect chain of 4Ch to the first stitch of the 14th row. (Image 142)

**15 row** 13Sc, 4Sc (into chain of Ch's) (17)

**15 – 21 rows** Sc in each Sc around (17)

Hide all the ends of yarn left from crocheting the cuff.

**22 row** INVDEC, 15Sc (16)

**23 row** INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, 3Sc, INVDEC, 2Sc, INVDEC (12)

**24 row** (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (9)

Insert the left arm into the sleeve. Place it so that the elbow is pointing through the hole.

**25 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

**17 – 21 rows** Sc in each Sc around (17)

Hide all the ends of yarn left from

INVDEC (12)

**24 row** (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (9)

Insert the right arm into the sleeve. Place it  
so that the elbow is pointing through the  
hole.

**25 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 3 times (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

- 9 – 10 rows Sc in each Sc around (9)
- 11 row 3Sc, INVDEC, 3Sc (1 stitch should be left uncrocheted) (7)
- 12 row INVDEC, 6Sc (crochet uncrocheted stitch) (7)
- 13 row Sc in each Sc around (7)
- 14 row 3Sc, INVDEC, 2Sc (6)
- 15 row Sc in each Sc around (6)
- 16 row INVDEC, 1Sc, INVDEC, 1Sc (4), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

**With crimson yarn**

- 4 row** (2Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (24)
- 5 – 7 rows** Sc in each Sc around (24)
- 8 row** (2Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 9 row** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (12)
- 10 row** 6INVDEC (6), Sl

Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

Little eye

- 1 row** 6Sc in magic circle (6)
- 2 row** 6INC (12)  
(1Sc, INC) repeat 6 times (18)
- 3 row** Sc in each Sc around (18)
- 4 – 5 rows** (1Sc, INVDEC) repeat 6 times (12)
- 6 row** 6INVDEC (6), Sl
- 7 row** Cut the yarn, leave a long end for sewing.

There is no need to fill the eyes with stuffing material. Squish the eyes as shown on the photo. (*Image 156*)

## 19. Teeth

### *With milky white yarn*

Second and sixth teeth

- 1 row 4Sc in magic circle (4)
- 2 row Sc in each Sc around (4), Sl

Third, fourth and fifth teeth

- 1 row 3Sc in magic circle (3), Sl

Cut the yarns, leave a long end for sewing on each tooth. The first tooth will be embroidered at a later stage.

Place the eyes symmetrically 3 rows higher than the mouth. Fasten them with pins for comfortable sewing if needed.

Sew the eyes, making a seam around the circumference.

Fasten and cut the yarn, hiding the end inside the head.

## 22.1 Assembly

Place the teeth from the top to the bottom, from left to right in given order: second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth. Fasten them with pins. (Image 163)

Sew them one by one with the ends of the yarns that we left before. Embroider the first tooth right after you finish sewing the other teeth. Its size should be smaller than the size of third tooth. (Image 164)

Connect mouline DMC 761 (pink) under the sixth tooth and embroider the gum, then embroider the gum above the first three teeth.

All yarns must be fastened and hidden inside the head.

## 22.2 Assembly

Embroider the nostrils and pupils with black yarn.

Place the eyelids above the corresponding eyes and sew them with the ends of the yarns that we left before.

Embroider the wrinkles on the forehead with black yarn.

All yarns must be fastened and hidden inside the head.

## 22.3 Assembly

Pick places for the hanks of hair. Take a short strand of DMC 310 (black - 2 threads), insert it into the needle and make a knot on the end of the yarn. (*Image 174*)

Insert the needle into the hole between Sc and pull it out through fiber of marsh green yarn. (*Image 175*)

Pull the black yarn (*Image 176*) in order to make the knot of the yarn enter inside the head and stuck in the place where the yarn has been pulled out through the fiber of marsh green yarn. (*Image 177*)

Cut the hair a little (5 mm).

Make a few more hanks of hair in the same way.

## 22.4 Assembly

Embroider the eye bags with black yarn.

Make a loop on the tie with the end of crimson yarn that we left before. Put the tie's loop onto the neck and and tighten it close to the collar to the collar.
