# **Sleepy Panda Baby Booties**

Crochet Pattern



Thank you for downloading my pattern, I really hope that you enjoy it!

## Size:

Pattern is made for 0 - 6 months old. Changes for size 6-12 months are in [].

#### Finished Measurements (Sole Length)

0 - 6 month old - 9cm

6 - 12 month old - 10cm

#### Gauge:

4 rows x 5 stitches in hdc = 1 inch

#### Materials:

3.50mm Crochet Hook
100yds 8ply Yarn (DK) – Drops Cotton Light (*In the colours "Black" and "White"*)
Tapestry Needle

#### Stitches Used:

st(s) - stitch(es) ch - chain stitch sl st - slip stitch sc - single crochet sc2tog - single crochet 2 together hdc - half double crochet hdc2tog - half double crochet 2 together

#### Special Stitches SC 2 together

Insert your hook into the next stitch. Yarn over, and pull back through that stitch (2 loops on hook). Insert your hook into the next stitch. Yarn over, and pull back through that stitch (3 loops on hook). Yarn over, and pull through all the loops on your hook.



## Sole:

Rnd 1– Ch11 [13] using "Black" yarn, 2 hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 1 hdc in next 8 [10] sts, 5 hdc in next st. (*Note: You are now going to be working on the opposite side of foundation chain.*) 1 hdc in next 8 [10] sts. 3 hdc in last st. (26 [30] sts) Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> hdc of this rnd.

Rnd 2– Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. 2 hdc in next 2 sts. 1 hdc in next 8 [10] sts. 2 hdc in next 5 sts. 1 hdc in next 8 [10] sts. 2 hdc in next 3 sts. (36 [40] sts) Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> hdc of this rnd.

Rnd 3– Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. \*2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Repeat from the \* twice. 1 hdc in next 8 [10] sts. \*2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Repeat from the \* 5 times. 1 hdc in next 8 [10] sts. \*2 hdc in next st. 1 hdc in next st. Repeat from the \* 3 times. Sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> st of this rnd. (46 [50] sts)

Fasten off, and weave in loose ends.



# Top Of Shoe:

Rnd 1– Attach yarn (Black) right in the middle of the heel. Ch1, 1 sc in the same st, but only through the back loop. (*Note: Continue crocheting the sts in this rnd, only in the back loop.*) 1 sc in next 45 [49] sts. Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of this rnd.

Rnd 2 – 3– Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. 1 sc in every st all around. Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of this rnd. (*Note: If you're creating the 6 – 12 month size, add 1 extra rnd to the original 2.)* Rnd 4– Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. 1 sc in next 13 [15] sts. \*1 sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Repeat from the \* 7 times. 1 sc in next 12 [14] sts. Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of this rnd. (39 [43] sts) **Rnd 5**- Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. 1 sc in 1st st, 1 sc2tog. 1 sc in next 9 [11] sts. \*1 sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Repeat from the \* 5 times. 1 sc in next 9 [11] sts. 1 sc2tog. 1 sc in next st. Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of this rnd. (32 [36] sts)



Rnd 6- Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. 1 sc in next 15 [17] sts. 2 hdc2tog. 1 sc in next 13 [15] sts. Do not sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc of this rnd. (30 [34] sts)

Rnd 7– Start crocheting in 1<sup>st</sup> st from the previous rnd. 1 sc in next 30 [34] Sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> st of this rnd. Fasten off, and weave in loose ends.

#### Head:

Rnd 1– Ch2 using "White" yarn, 6 hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, Join with sl st in first hdc. (6 sts) Rnd 2– Ch1. 2 hdc in next 6 sts. Join with sl st in first hdc. (12 sts)



Rnd 3– Ch1, 1 hdc in same st. 2 hdc in next 4 sts. 1 hdc in next 2 sts. 2 hdc in next 4 sts. 1 hdc in next st. Join with sl st in first hdc. (20 sts)

Rnd 4– Ch1, 1 sc in same st. 1 sc in next st. 2 sc in next 6 sts. 1 sc in next 4 sts. 2 sc in next 6 sts. 1 sc in next 2 sts. Join with sl st in first sc. (32 sts) Fasten off, and weave in loose ends.

Repeat "Head" pattern four times. Sew/join 2 together, making sure to stuff the head with a bit of toy stuffing before completely sewing the 2 sections together.

Sew a completed "Head" onto each bootie, towards

the front.

Embroider a pair of sleepy eyes onto each head using black yarn.

#### Ears & Nose:

<u>Ears</u>

**Rnd** 1– Ch2 using "Black" yarn, 4 hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook. Ch2. Join with sl st in first hdc. (4 sts) Fasten off, and weave in loose ends.

Repeat "Ear" pattern four times. Sew 2 ears onto each head, towards the top, making sure to space them out evenly.

<u>Nose</u>

Using black yarn, Ch3, then sl st in first ch. Fasten off, and weave in loose ends.

Repeat "Nose" pattern twice. Sew 1 nose onto each head, just beneath the sleepy eyes.
