SIZE

YARN

Rowan Kid Classic

8	8	9	x 50gm
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NEEDLES

1 pair 3¼mm (no 9) (US 5) needles

1 pair 4½mm (no 7) (US 7) needles

Cable needle

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over st st using 4½mm (US 7) needles.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

C6B = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at back of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle; **C6F** = slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K3, then K3 from cable needle.

BACK

Using 4½mm (US 7) needles cast on 106 [110: 114] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 18 rows, dec 1 st at end of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 105 [109: 113] sts.**

Beg with a K row, work in st st, shaping side seams by dec 1 st at each end of 21st and 3 foll 24th rows. 97 [101: 105] sts.

Cont straight until back meas 53 [54: 55] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 3 [4: 5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 91 [93: 95] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 5 alt rows. 71 [73: 75] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 19 [20: 21] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape back neck and shoulders

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 61 [63: 65] sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 5 sts, K until there are 9 sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 33 [35: 37] sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back to **.

Beg with a K row, work in st st, shaping side seams by dec 1 st at each end of 21st and foll 24th row, ending with **WS** facing for next row. 101 [105: 109] sts.

Next row (WS): P25 [26: 27], (M1, P1) 3 times, M1, P45 [47: 49], (M1, P1) 3 times, M1, P to end. 109 [113: 117] sts.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): K23 [24: 25], P1, C6B, K3, P1, K41 [43: 45], P1, K3, C6F, P1, K to end.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: P21 [22: 23], K3, P9, K3, P37 [39: 41], K3, P9, K3, P to end.

Row 3: K23 [24: 25], P1, K9, P1, K41 [43: 45], P1, K9, P1, K to end.

Row 5: K23 [24: 25], P1, K3, C6F, P1, K41 [43: 45], P1, C6B, K3, P1, K to end.

Row 7: As row 3.

Row 8: As row 2.

These 8 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, dec 1 st at each end of 15th and foll 24th row. 105 [109: 113] sts.

Cont straight until 14 rows less have been worked than on back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Now work in yoke patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Patt 36 [37: 38] sts, K33 [35: 37], patt to end.

Row 2: Patt 36 [37: 38] sts, K1, (P1, K1) 16 [17: 18] times, patt to end.

These 2 rows form yoke patt.

Cont in yoke patt until front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 [4: 5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 99 [101: 103] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on foll 5 alt rows. 79 [81: 83] sts.

Work 3 [5: 7] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape neck

Next row (WS): Patt 32 [33: 34] sts and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 8 rows, then on foll 3 [4: 5] alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 19 sts.

Cont straight until front matches back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 7 sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 15 sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ mm (US 5) needles cast on 46 [50: 50] sts.

Work in rib as given for back for 5 cm, inc [dec: inc] 1 st at centre of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 47 [49: 51] sts.

Change to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (US 7) needles.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: P18 [19: 20], K1, (P1, K1) 5 times, P to end.

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd and every foll 6th row to 69 [77: 83] sts, then on 3 [1: 0] foll 8th rows, taking inc sts into st st. 75 [79: 83] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 42 [43: 44] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 [4: 5] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 69 [71: 73] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row until 49 sts rem, then on foll 7 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 35 sts.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 4 rows.

Cast off rem 19 sts.

MAKING UP

Press.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Neckband

With RS facing and using 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ mm (US 5) needles, pick up and knit 35 [36: 39] sts down left side of neck, 15 sts from front, 35 [36: 39] sts up right side of neck, then 41 [43: 45] sts from back. 126 [130: 138] sts.

Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back for 11 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off in rib.

Pockets (make 2)

Using 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ mm (US 7) needles cast on 32 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K3, (P2, K2) 7 times, K1.

Row 2: K1, P2, (K2, P2) 7 times, K1.

Rows 3 to 6: As rows 1 and 2, twice.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: K1, P to last st, K1.

Rows 9 to 30: As rows 7 and 8, 11 times.

Row 31: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 30 sts.

Row 32: As row 8.

Rows 33 and 34: As rows 7 and 8.

Row 35: As row 31. 28 sts.

Row 36: As row 8.

Row 37: K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 26 sts.

Row 38: K1, P2tog, P to last 3 sts, P2tog tbl, K1. 24 sts.

Rows 39 and 40: As rows 37 and 38.

Cast off rem 20 sts.

Using photograph as a guide, sew pockets onto fronts.

Set in sleeves using the set-in method.
