





Crochet Pattern

Start Here...

- · Please, read the whole pattern through properly so you have a good overview.
- · The little dino amigurumi is made up of the following parts:
 - · 1 Head with 2 Eyes, 2 Cheeks and 2 Spikes
 - · 1 Body (with 2 Spikes) and broken eggshell (with Spots)
 - · 2 Arms
 - · 2 Legs
- · The dino egg amigurumi is made up of the following parts:
 - · 1 Egg (with Spots)
 - · 2 Legs
- · Little Dino measurements (height including spikes): 6.7 inches (17 cm).
- · Dino Egg measurements (height): 3.1 inches (8 cm).

Materials (for 1 Little Dino and 1 Dino Egg)

- · 3.75 mm crochet hook
- · Sport Yarn: Turquoise (20 grams), Orange (30 grams), Red (45 grams), Light Blue (just a little), Light Red (just a little).
- · Thread: Black (just a little), Light Blue (just a little), Light Red (just a little).
- · Cushion Stuffing.
- · 2 Amigurumi Safety Eyes 12mm.
- · Scissors & needle.

Notes

- · The ch and sl st are not included in the stitch count of each round.
- · Note that the orientation of all parts of the pattern are set looking at the project from the front.

Generic Processes

Sew Edges

It's an easy process. Just take your piece, flatten it, and sew the open edges closed. Depending on the pattern, you should fasten off or leave a long tail to sew it later.







Crochet Pattern

Little Dino

Head:

- · You must stuff this part little by little as you crochet them, making the process easier.
- · This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With turquoise yarn create a Magic Ring with 8 sc.

1 round: 1 sc in each sc (8 sts). 2 round: 2 sc in each sc (16 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (22 sts).

4 to 6 round: 1 sc in each st (22 sts, 3 rounds in total).

7 round: 1 sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, 1 sc in next 9 sc (26 sts).

8 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (28 sts).

9 to 15 round: 1 sc in each sc (28 sts, 7 rounds in total).

· I used amigurumi safety eyes for this pattern. Place them centered, between rounds 12 and 13. For your reference the eyes have a distance of 5 sts between them.

Note: If you don't want to use amigurumi safety eyes, you can do the eyes with stitches. With black yarn make several stitches for each eye. Place them in round 13. For your reference the eyes have a distance of 5 sts between them.

· Now you must make and sew the cheeks. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation below.

16 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog * repeat 3 more times (22 sts).

17 round: 1 sc in each sc (22 sts).

18 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (18 sts).
19 round: * 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (12 sts).
20 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (8 sts).

21 round: * sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (6 sts).

- · Using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close. Fasten off.
- · Now you must make and sew the spikes. To learn how to make them, please see the explanation on page 6.

Cheek: (x2)

- · With pink yarn create a Magic Ring with 4 hdc. Join with sl st. Fasten off.
- · With pink thread sew the cheeks on the head. Place them on both sides, right and left, between rounds 14 and 16. Fasten off.



Crochet Pattern

Big Spike: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With yellow yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 2 more times (16 sts).

3 round: 1 sc in each sc (16 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

- · Sew the edges of each spike following the instructions on page 3, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".
- · Now sew 2 spikes on the head. Place them centered. The first one between rounds 5 and 7, and the second between rounds 12 and 15. Fasten off.

Body:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With turquoise yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: *1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 5 more times (22 sts).

3 to 10 round: 1 sc in each sc (22 sts, 8 rounds in total).

11 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 3 more times (16 sts).

12 to 14 round: 1 sc in each sc (16 sts, 3 rounds in total).

15 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (12 sts).

16 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (9 sts).

17 to 22 round: 1 sc in each sc (9 sts, 6 rounds in total). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Stuff the body.

Broken Eggshell:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With white yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 1 sc in each sc (6 sts).

2 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (24 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (28 sts).

5 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (36 sts).

6 to 10 round: 1 sc in each sc (36 sts, 5 rounds in total).

11 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (30 sts).

12 to 15 round: 1 sc in each sc (30 sts, 4 rounds in total). Fasten off.

Big Spot: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With light blue yarn create a Magic Ring with 8 hdc.

1 round: 1 sc in each sc (8 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Sew the spots randomly on the broken eggshell.



Crochet Pattern

Arm: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With turquoise yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).
2 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 3 more times (15 sts).

4 to 6 round: 1 sc in each sc (15 sts, 3 rounds in total).

7 round: * 1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (12 sts).

8 to 9 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 2 rounds in total). Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

· Sew the edges of each arm following the instructions on page 2, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".

Leg: (x2)

· You must stuff this part little by little as you crochet them, making the process easier.

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With turquoise yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 1 sc in each sc (6 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (15 sts).

3 to 6 round: 1 sc in each sc (15 sts, 4 rounds in total).

9 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (12 sts).

10 to 13 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts, 4 rounds in total).

14 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (9 sts). Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing that

piece later.

· You should sew the edges of each leg following the instructions on page 2, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".

Finishing the Little Dino Amigurumi:

- · With turquoise yarn sew the head to the body.
- · Now sew the arms on both sides of the body, right and left, between rounds 15 and 16.
- · Then sew the legs on the eggshell. Place them on both sides of the eggshell, right and left, between rounds 8 and 12.
- · Fasten off all yarns.



Crochet Pattern

Egg:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With white yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

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1 round: 2 sc in each sc (12 sts).
2 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts).
3 round: * 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (18 sts).
4 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc * repeat 5 more times (20 sts).
5 to 13 round: 1 sc in each sc (20 sts, 9 rounds in total).
14 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (18 sts).
15 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 5 sc * repeat 2 more times (14 sts).
16 to 18 round: 1 sc in each sc (14 sts, 3 rounds in total).
19 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc2tog * repeat 2 more times (12 sts).
20 round: * 1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc in next 4 sc * repeat 2 more times (10 sts).
1 sc in each sc (10 sts, 3 rounds in total).
24 round: * sc2tog * repeat 5 more times (6 sts).
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· Now using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close. Fasten off.


Spots:

- · Make 4 spots and 3 big spots in light red yarn.
- · Sew the spots randomly on the egg.


Leg: (x2)

- · Make the legs of the little dino from round 1 to 6, in red yarn as main color and blue yarn as secondary color.
- \cdot Then sew the legs on both sides of the egg, right and left, between rounds 6 and 8. Remember that you must place them perpendicular to the egg.

















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
