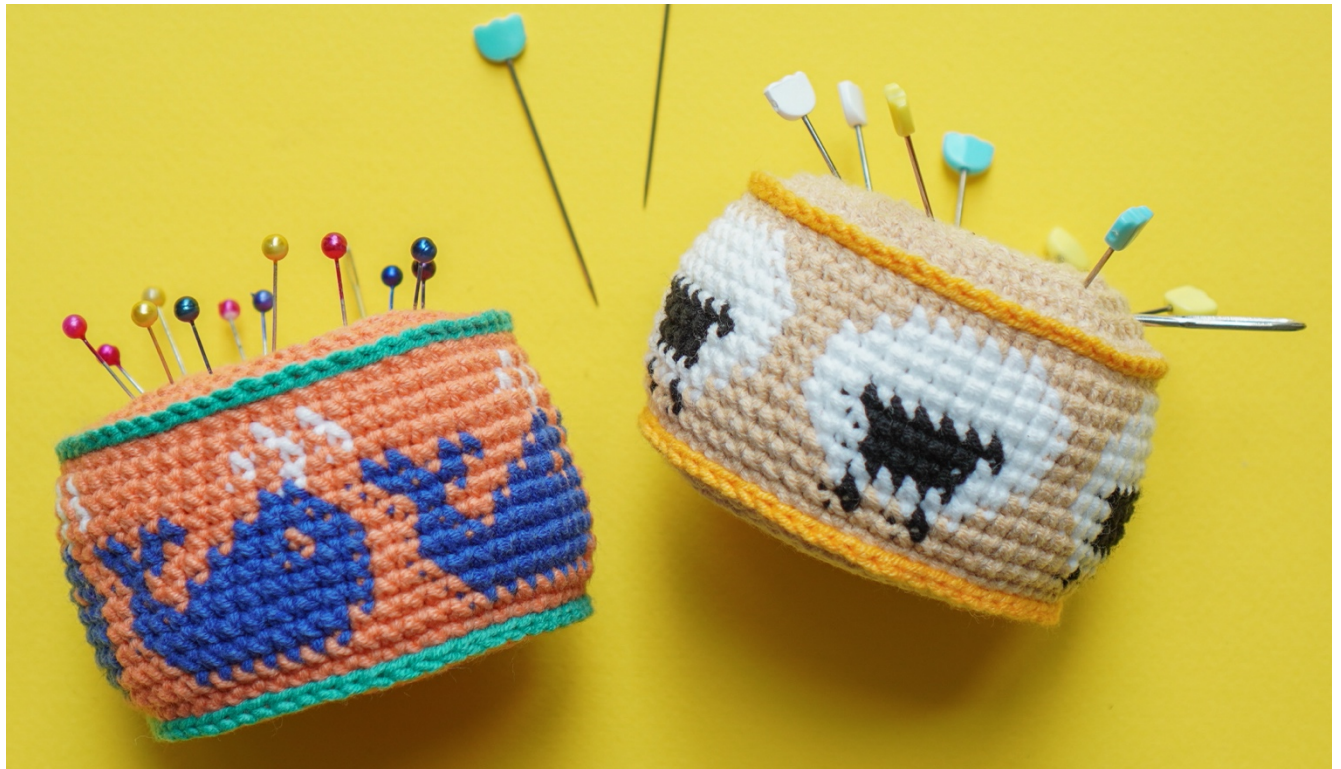


# PIN CUSHION

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## MATERIALS

### Yarns

#### Whale version

Color A: orange **YarnArt Jeans** 23 (50g, 160m)

Color B: white **YarnArt Jeans** 62 (50g, 160m)

Color C: blue **YarnArt Jeans** 47 (50g, 160m)

Color D: turquoise **Baby Jeans** 41 (40g, 128m)

#### Sheep version

Color A: beige **Baby Jeans** 29 (40g, 128m)

Color B: white **YarnArt Jeans** 62 (50g, 160m)

Color C: black **Baby Jeans** 34 (40g, 128m)

Color D: yellow **Baby Jeans** 63 (40g, 128m)

### Other materials

- Crochet hook size 2.5mm
- Tapestry needles, brow thread, pins, stitch markers, scissors, polyester fiberfill

### ABBREVIATIONS – US TERMS

<b>Ch</b>	Chain
<b>Sc</b>	Single Crochet
<b>Inc</b>	Single Crochet Increase
<b>Dec</b>	Single Crochet Decrease
<b>Hdc</b>	Half Double Crochet
<b>Slst</b>	Slip Stitch
<b>Mr</b>	Magic Ring
<b>Dc</b>	Double Crochet
<b>Tr</b>	Treble Crochet

### ABBREVIATIONS – US TERMS

<b>(...)</b>	Work all stitches in the same stitch
<b>[...]...x</b>	Repeat instructions in brackets...times
<b>Bobble</b>	Bobble Stitch
<b>BLO</b>	Back loop only
<b>FLO</b>	Front loop only
<b>Rnd</b>	Round
<b>Sts</b>	Stitches

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Same Base (yarn A)

rnd		sts
1	sc 6 into a magic loop	(6)
2	inc 6	(12)
3	[sc 1, inc 1] 6x	(18)
4	sc 1, inc 1, [sc 2, inc 1] 5x, sc 1	(24)
5	[sc 3, inc 1] 6x	(30)
6	sc 2, inc 1, [sc 4, inc 1] 5x, sc 2	(36)
7	[sc 5, inc 1] 6x	(42)
8	sc 3, inc 1, [sc 6, inc 1] 5x, sc 3 (if you are using bigger yarn/just want to make a smaller cushion, stop here and move to the Whale or Sheep pattern, if you make a bigger one, continue to crochet as long as the total number can divide for 12)	(48)
9	[sc 7, inc 1] 6x	(54)
10	sc 4, inc 1, [sc 8, inc 1] 5x, sc 4	(60)
11	(BLO) sc 60	(60)

From this rnd, you can choose between Whale & Sheep pattern. The color will change as the letter color (check the color on yarn material)

### Whale Pattern (yarn A)

12	sc 8, [sc 1, sc 1, sc 1, sc 9] 4x, sc 1, sc 1, sc 1, sc 1	(60)
13	[sc 7, sc 1, sc 1, sc 1, sc 1, sc 1] 5x	(60)
14	sc 9, [sc 1, sc 11] 4x, sc 1, sc 2, break yarn B	(60)
15	[sc 2, sc 1, sc 2, sc 3, sc 2, sc 2] 5x	(60)
16	[sc 1, sc 3, sc 3, sc 4, sc 1] 5x	(60)
17	[sc 2, sc 1, sc 3, sc 3, sc 1, sc 2] 5x	(60)
18	[sc 2, sc 2, sc 1, sc 7] 5x	(60)
19	[sc 2, sc 10] 5x	(60)
20	[sc 3, sc 9] 5x	(60)
21	[sc 4, sc 7, sc 1] 5x, break yarn C	(60)
22-23	sc 60 (2 rnds)	(60)

24	(BLO) [sc 8, dec 1] 6x	(54)
25	[sc 7, dec 1] 6x	(48)
26	[sc 6, dec 1] 6x	(42)
27	[sc 5, dec 1] 6x	(36)
28	[sc 4, dec 1] 6x	(30)
29	[sc 3, dec 1] 6x, start stuffing not too much as usual, just enough to make it puffy	(24)
30	[sc 2, dec 1] 6x	(18)
31	[sc 1, dec 1] 6x	(12)
32	dec 6	(6)

Break the yarn with a really long rest, weave in the last 6 sts. Use the tapestry needle to pull from the middle bottom to the middle front of the stand to make a concave each side (see Assembling part). Join yarn D on the last st of rnd 11, crochet slst till the end on the remaining sts. Turn the cushion up side down, join yarn D on the first st of rnd 24, crochet slst till the end on the remaining sts. Hide the remaining yarn.

### Sheep Pattern (yarn A)

12	[sc 4, sc 6, sc 2] 5x	(60)
13	[sc 3, sc 8, sc 1] 5x	(60)
14-15	[sc 2, sc 10] 5x (2 rnds)	(60)
16	[sc 2, sc 2, sc 6, sc 2] 5x	(60)
17	[sc 2, sc 3, sc 4, sc 3] 5x	(60)
18	[sc 3, sc 2, sc 4, sc 2, sc 1] 5x	(60)
19	[sc 4, sc 6, sc 2] 5x, break yarn B	(60)
20	[sc 5, sc 1, sc 2, sc 1, sc 3] 5x, break yarn C	(60)
21-22	sc 60 (2 rnds)	(60)
23-31	Crochet as rnd 24-32 of the Whale Pattern	(6)

Just do as the Whale Pattern.

## ASSEMBLING

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Crochet as instructed

Start stuffing not too much as usual, just enough to make it puffy



Start stuffing not too much as usual, just enough to make it puffy



Weave in the last 6 sts.



Weave in the last 6 sts.



Pull from the middle bottom to the middle front of the stand to make a concave each side



Push the needle to the other side of the cushion



Pull the yarn gently



Just enough force to make a concave like this



Repeat pulling the yarn from 1 side to the other side of the cushion 4-5 times



Until each side has a concave like this, break the yarn, hide the remaining yarn





## ASSEMBLING

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Join yarn D on the last st of rnd 11



Crochet slst till the end on the remaining sts



Hide the remaining yarn



Turn the cushion up side down, join yarn D on the first st of rnd 24



Crochet slst till the end on the remaining sts



Hide the remaining yarn
