## ⚠ WARNING

- Read all the instructions in this manual before using this product.
- Failure to follow these warnings and the assembly instructions could result in danger.
- Adult assembly required.
- DOT NOT leave infant in this product unsupervised.
- DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT FOR INFANT SLEEP.
- Infants should be placed to sleep on a firm, flat surface.
- DO NOT put objects or accessories in an infant's sleep environment.
- DO NOT place this product near a blind, cord, strap or similar item that could become wrapped around an infant's neck.
- PLACE INFANT ON THEIR BACK WHEN USING THIS PRODUCT.
- Always use the restraint system when using this product.
- When using as a reclined cradle in rocker mode: Always use the most reclined position for newborns. STOP using the product when the child starts trying to sit up or weights more than 9kg (approximately 0-6months).
- When using as an inclined cradle in infant chair mode: Only use more upright angles when the child is able to support and move their head freely in those upright positions.
- Never use the toy bar to carry the product.
- Never use this product on an elevated surface (e.g. a table).
- Never let the child sleep in this product. This product does not replace a cot or a crib. Should the child fall asleep, then it should be placed in a suitable cot or crib.
- Be aware of the risk of open fire and other sources of strong heat such as electric bar fires, gas fires, etc. in the vicinity of the product.
- DO NOT let children play with this product.
- DO NOT move or lift this product with the baby inside it.

- DO NOT use the product if any parts are broken, torn or missing.
- DO NOT use accessories or substitute parts other than those approved by the manufacturer.
- Check this product regularly. All assembly fittings should be correctly assembled and tightened properly before using the product.
- Ensure batteries are inserted with the correct polarity.
- Do not mixed different types of batteries or new and used batteries.
- Change batteries when product ceases to operate satisfactorily.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the product before being charged. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Exhausted batteries are to be removed from the product.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Keep the batteries out of children's reach.
- To prevent possible injury by entanglement, remove the toys when the child starts trying to get up on its hands and knees in a crawling position.
- To avoid suffocation, remove plastic bag and packaging materials before using this product. The plastic bag and packaging materials should then be kept away from babies and children.
- Check this product regularly before using it, and do not use it if any part is loose or missing or if there are any signs of damage. Do not substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer if replacement parts or additional instructions are needed.

## Care and Maintenance
