

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

In case of abnormality



In case of abnormality in case an abnormal noise or smell is generated from the unit during use, immediately switch the power of, unplug the power cord from the power outlet, and consult your dealer or an authorized service center for a check-up.

Do not open the unit.



Hith-voltage components are used inside the unit. Do not open the cabinet to check or modify the unit, for this will cause the danger of electric shock. Performance degradation or malfunction due to the user modification will not be covered by the warranty.

Do not exceed the maximum power capacity.



The components equipped with the rear panel AC OUT-LETS accept the connection of other stereo system components.

However, do not connect competes the total power consumption of which exceed the power capacity marked on the panel, for this may cause malfunction of fire hazard.

Also note that components in which large current flows when the power is switched on, such as a TV, cannot be connected to such an AC outlet unless it has been designed to accept the connection of a TV set.

Keep away from water and foreign objects.



Do not insert or drop metallic objects, such as a hairpin, nail and coin, or flammable objects, such as paper and matches, through the ventilation holes or other openings on the unit, for this will cause malfunction or hazard of fire and electrics shock. In case water or a foreign object enters inside the unit, consult an authorized service center or your dealer for a check-up.

Do not damage the power cord.



Hold the power plug when plugging or unplugging the power cord. Do not pull the cord or touch in with wet hands, for this may cause short-circuit or or electronic hazard. Do not leave the power cord under this unit. Or under furniture, or between objects

When the unit is not to be used for a long period.



These openings must not be blocked or covered. If they are blocked or covered accidentally, the inside temperature will rise, and cause a fire. There are ventilation openings on upper and bottom of the case to prevent overheating.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS

Do not install the unit in following places....

- In a place which is exposed to direct sunlight or near a aource of heat such as a radiator.
- In a place where the heat cannot escape due to poor ventilation, or where is very humid or dusty.
- In a unstable place with excessive vibrations or sloping.
- In a place which may be exposed to rain, such as near a window.
- In a place which may be exposed to soot, vapor or heat, such as near a cooking table.

BEFORE CONNECTIONS

Connection precautions


- Be sure to switch the powers of the related equipment before making any connection
- the white input/out jacks fo the amplifier are designed for the lfet channel, while the red jacks are for the right channel. Be sure to connect the cords without mistaking the correspondences of the left and right channels.
- Insert the plug of the connection cords securely into the jacks. If the connection is incomplete, sound may not be produce or noise may be generated.
- When unplugging the power cord from the power outlet, be sure to grasp the plastic molting of the plug and pull.


Power consumption of AC power outlets

- Be careful that the total power consumption does not exceed the wattage marked on the rear panel. Do not connect other appliances than the system components to the power outlets of this unit.
- Do not connect a TV set to this until even if the power consumption value marked on a TV et is below the permissible limit of this unit, a larger current that the permissible value may flow when the TV power is turned on.

[FRONT PANEL]






CONNECTION OF SPEAKER CORDS

- Press down the button as illustration, insert the cords into the hole.
- 2.Spring of the button will fix the cords.
 Please select the suitable speaker cords and connect it through the shortest path.

This unit could connect one or two group speakers simultaneously. If only connect one group speakers, you can select connect group A or group B. And please note that phase of the speaker cords are correct or not, if not, the sound will be felt unnatural and absence of low frequency.




Attention: ends of the cords should not touch each other.




Connecting the RCA pin plugs

When connecting RCA pin plugs, be sure to insert yellow plug into yellow jack, red plug into the red jack and the white plug into the white jack.



SYSTEM CONNECTIONS



OPERATION

- 1. Press power switch 5 to turn it on.
- Insert microphones into microphone input jacks <u>11</u>, adjust volume by microphone volume control <u>13</u>.
- 3. Adjust timbre of human voice:

Treble: Revolve treble 10 to boost or cut high frequency, note avoid high frequency whistle

Bass Revolve bass 9 to boost or cut low frequency, note avoid low frequency whistle.

4. Microphone master volume control

Set value of microphone master volume control $\underline{2}$ between 18-20, then operate it from step 2 to step 3.

5. Echo effection

Set value of echo effection control $\underline{7}$ in the middle, then adjust delay $\underline{6}$ and repeat $\underline{8}$ and talk simultaneously until you feel satisfied.

- 6. Select input signal sources.
- 7. Adjust music volume

Revolve music volume cotrol $\,\underline{4}\,$ from left to right until you feel satisfied.

8. Adjust music quality

Adjust high frequency through revolving treble <u>16</u> and low frequency through revolving bass <u>15</u> until you feel satisfied.

9.Microphones

Keep a certain distance between the microphones and the speakers or decrease the microphone volume when whistle happens.

Keep a certain distance and angle between the microphone and your mouth.

Switch the microphones off and pull it out from jacks when you don't need to use microphones.

10.Whistle inhibition

- A: Set the value of microphone volume control 2 between 8-10.
- B: Adjust microphone volume and music volume Simultaneously until balance.
